Start Date: November 2022 • End Date: June 13, 2023



This notice provides an update on the replacement of the watermain and the City-owned portion of substandard water services on Grace Street from Bloor Street West to Dundas Street West.

To provide residents with some peace and quiet over the holidays, this work will be paused. The last day for construction work in this area is expected to be December 23, 2022. The work is expected to resume on January 16, 2023,

We know this project has an impact to all businesses and residents along Grace Street. We appreciate your patience with the inconveniences.


### REMAINING WORK

The City's contractor will complete:

- the watermain installation, including branches and hydrants
- watermain testing and commissioning
- connection of all water services to the newly installed watermain
- restoration of all areas affected by construction, including road, curb, sidewalk, driveway, landscaped areas and sod.

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.





### Construction Update 1



**Parking:** This project will affect on-street parking. Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated with no charge to the owner. Please call 416-808-2222 for its location.



Parking Violation Notices: Please ensure you park in a legal parking spot at all times. If parking enforcement is called to a street, officers must issue a yellow parking violation notice (ticket) to vehicles in violation of parking by-laws. If you receive a yellow notice during this construction work, please do one of the following within 15 days of the notice date in order to avoid additional fines or records being kept of non-payment:

- 1. Pay the parking violation (follow instructions on the back of the notice); or
- File a Parking Violation Dispute with the City online, by mail, or in person (follow instructions on the back of the notice). As part of the dispute process, you may include the construction notice and/or other documentation related to parking impacts resulting from construction.

If you do not have a copy of the Construction Notice, please call 311 for a copy. **Please note:** Violation notices cannot be cancelled if vehicles are parked in illegal parking spots (i.e. in front of a fire hydrant or in No Parking zones).

In an effort to reduce ticketing due to construction, please exercise patience with neighbours who are experiencing construction impacts and may need to temporarily park on your street.



Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the **Field Ambassador** listed below.
