
Watermain Replacement on Aldwych Avenue

Contract: 22ECS-LU-07SU
Start Date: August 29, 2022
Expected End Date: December 30, 2022
New End Date: June 9, 2023
*Timeline is subject to change.

This notice provides an update on the replacement of the watermain and the City-owned portion of substandard water services on Aldwych Avenue. Work on this project is currently behind schedule. Since the remaining work can only be completed during favourable weather conditions, this work has been postponed to next spring. The last day for construction work in this area is expected to be during the week of December 19, 2022. Construction activities are expected to resume on April 25, 2023, and has a revised end date of June 9, 2023.

We know this project has an impact to all businesses and residents along Aldwych Avenue. We sympathize and appreciate your patience with the dust, noise, fencing and other inconveniences while we work to improve important City infrastructure.

To date the City's contractor has:

- Completed the watermain installation.
- Completed the water service connections.
- Completed temporary restoration.

REMAINING WORK

The City's contractor will complete:

- Permanent restoration of watermain trench.
- Permanent restoration of concrete sidewalks, curbs and driveways.
- Milling of asphalt, utility adjustments and base repairs.
- Paving of asphalt.
- · Routing & sealing, and pavement marking.
- · Sod repairs.
