Watermain Replacement on Martin Grove Road from Rexdale Boulevard to Westhumber Boulevard

Contract: 22ECS-LU-02SU Start Date: October 24, 2022 - End Date: September 2023 Winter Shutdown Begins: December 23, 2022 - Work Resumes: Spring 2023 *Timeline is subject to change.

The City of Toronto's project to replace the watermain and the City-owned portion of substandard water services on Martin Grove Road is progressing. This update is to inform the local community that there will be a winter shutdown of construction activities for this project. Work this year wrapped up on December 23 and will resume in the spring of 2023.

Prior to leaving the site, the contractor will temporarily restore driveways, sidewalk/curbs, and the roadway with temporary asphalt, and will temporarily restore lawn areas with soil. Once weather conditions are favourable, the contractor will return in the spring of 2023 to complete the watermain and water service work and permanently restore the curb/ sidewalk, sod, and roadway. A construction update notice will be issued before work re-starts.

 - Completed street connection on Jeffcoat and Martin Grove intersection
- Completed temporary restoration at the above noted locations

REMAINING WORK

In the spring of 2023, the contractor will:

- Complete the watermain installation and water service connections on:
 Martin Grove from Rexdale Boulevard to Westhumber Boulevard
- Complete permanent restoration of areas affected by the watermain and water service installation.
