The City of Toronto is planning to resurface Wilmington Avenue from Kennard Avenue to Overbrook Place, and from Cavotti Crescent to Finch Avenue West. Our inspection of the road shows that it needs repaving, and sections of damaged curb and sidewalk also need to be replaced to bring them up to a state of good repair. Bicycle lanes will be reinstated on both sides as well. This project is part of the Council-approved 2022 Capital Works Program.

WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark sidewalks and curbs requiring replacement and the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable - to avoid interfering with these services.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work and issues such as parking.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

	<p>Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible.
