TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE

Fenside Drive between Lynedock Crescent and York Mills Road

Contract: 20ECS-LU-07FP

Start Date: February 7, 2023 - End Date: March 15, 2023

The City of Toronto is modifying and upgrading the storm sewer system in your area to help reduce surface and basement flooding. Due to the size and nature of the storm sewer construction work on Fenside Drive, for safety the road needs to be closed between Lynedock Crescent and York Mills Road. Work will proceed in *two stages*, starting at 7 a.m. on Tuesday February 7, 2023.

Stage 1 Closure: will commence at 7 a.m. on Tuesday, February 7 and is planned to conclude at 7 p.m. on Tuesday, February 28 - from 73 Fenside Drive to York Mills Road.

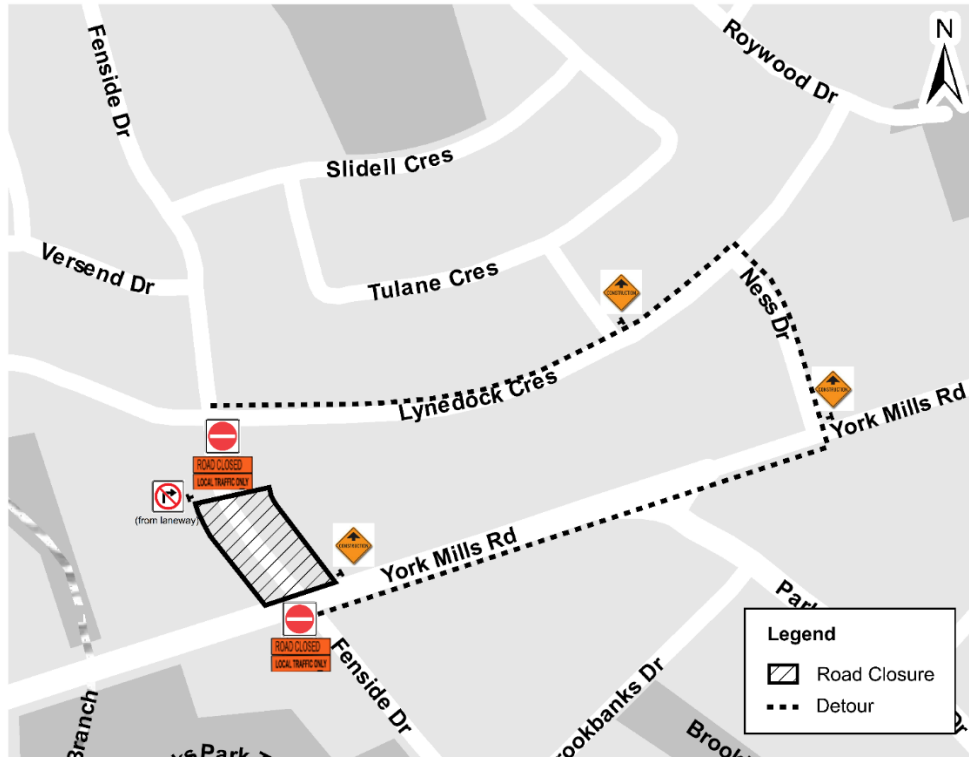
Stage 2 Closure: will commence at 7 a.m. on Wednesday, March 1, and is planned to conclude at 7 p.m. on Wednesday, March 15 - from 73 Fenside Drive to Lynedock Crescent.

See the maps below for closure and detour information. During the road closures, the Contractor will continue to allow access for local property owners and emergency services.

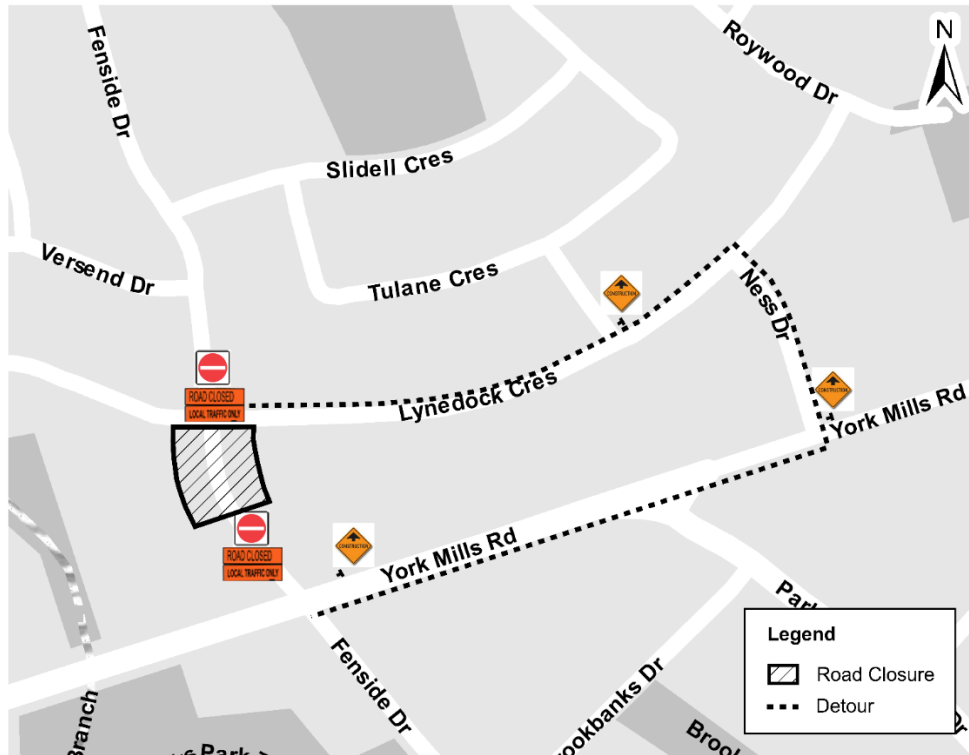
Drivers are reminded to abide by traffic/construction signs posted in local areas to ensure the safe travel of all local road users, pedestrians, and cyclists. This project is part of the Council-approved 2020 Basement Flooding Protection Program to improve the water distribution system, renew our aging infrastructure and reduce the risk of sewer breakage or blockages that cause sewer backups and flooding.

	<p>Traffic Management:</p> <p>Stage 1: Fenside Drive will be fully closed to outside traffic between 73 Fenside Drive and York Mills Road.</p> <p>Stage 2: Fenside Drive will be fully closed to outside traffic between 73 Fenside Drive and Lynedock Crescent.</p> <p>Local traffic, including access to all driveways, will be maintained.</p>
	<p>Pedestrians: Sidewalks will be kept open for pedestrian use. When work is taking place on the sidewalk, signage will be placed to provide information about which side of the road to use.</p>
	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
