The City of Toronto is modifying and upgrading the storm and sanitary sewer system in your area in order to help reduce surface and basement flooding.


Due to the depth and nature of the sanitary sewer construction work on Foxwarren Drive the road will be closed between Millgate Crescent and Bayview Avenue effective 7:00am on Monday February 6, 2023, to 7:00pm on Monday February 27, 2023.

Motorists are reminded to abide by traffic/construction signs posted in local areas to ensure the safe travel of all local road users, pedestrians, and cyclists. This project is part of the Council-approved 2020 Basement Flooding Protection Program to improve the water distribution system; renew our aging infrastructure and reduce the risk of sewer collapse or blockages that cause sewer backups and flooding.
