Overnight Tunneling Activities on Keele Street and Tangiers Road

Start Date: March 1, 2023 End Date: September 30, 2023

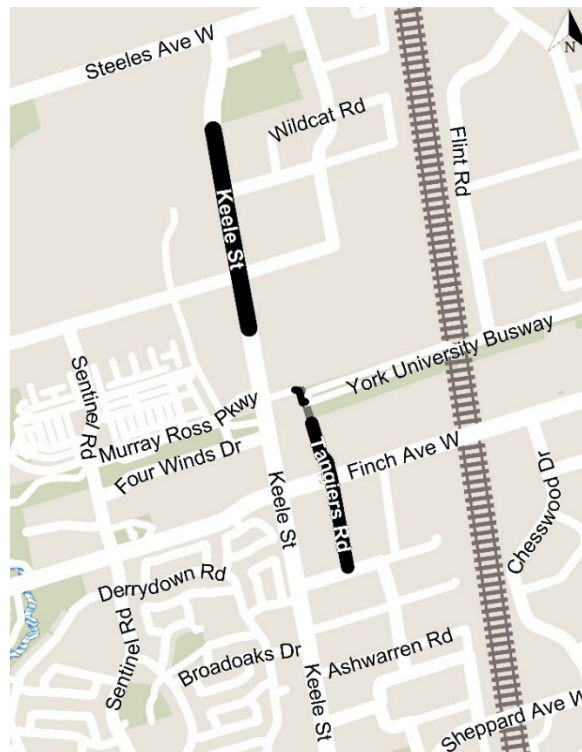

The City of Toronto's work on the new Downsview transmission watermain is progressing well. This notice is to provide an update that tunneling works to install the watermain on Keele Street and Tangiers Road will be conducted overnight (i.e., 7 p.m. to 7 a.m.) to expedite the construction schedule and reduce daytime disruptions. This includes work on Keele Street from south of Steeles Avenue to north of Murray Ross Parkway, and Tangiers Road, from the York University Busway to Toro Road (see map).

The contractor will carry out overnight tunnelling activities on Keele Street and Tangiers Road during weekday nights (i.e., from **Monday at 7 p.m. to Saturday at 7 a.m.**) from March to September 2023. The roadway construction staging configuration will remain the same as the daytime layout.




When this overnight work is complete, regular work hours will resume. Your patience and understanding are appreciated during this disruption. Thank you for your patience during this overnight work.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management:</p> <p>Traffic staging and construction areas will remain the same as daytime activities.</p>
	<p>Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.</p>
