
# Watermain Replacement and Road Resurfacing on Denvale Road

Contract: 22ECS-LU-07SU
Start Date: August 15, 2022
Restart Date: April 24, 2023
End Date: June 5, 2023
\*Timeline is subject to change.

This notice provides an update on the replacement of the watermain and the City-owned portion of substandard water services on Denvale Road. Work on this project is currently behind schedule. Since the remaining work can only be completed during favourable weather conditions, the restoration activities are expected to resume on April 24, 2023, and has an end date of June 5, 2023.

We know this project has an impact to all businesses and residents along Denvale Road. We sympathize and appreciate your patience with the dust, noise, fencing and other inconveniences.

#### **WORK STATUS TO DATE**

The City's contractor has:

- Completed the watermain installation.
- Completed the water service connections.
- Completed temporary restoration.
- Completed the permanent restoration of concrete sidewalks, curbs and driveways.

### **REMAINING WORK**

The City's contractor will complete:

- Milling of asphalt, utility adjustments and base repairs.
- Paving of asphalt.
- Routing and sealing, and pavement marking.
- Sod repairs.
