TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE Brian Drive at Clematis Road

Contract: 20ECS-LU-06FP Start Date: November 7, 2022 End Date: March 31, 2023 New End Date: April 28, 2023 *Timeline is subject to change.

The City of Toronto is modifying and upgrading the storm and sanitary sewer system in your area in order to reduce surface and basement flooding. This work also involves replacing the city-owned portion of substandard water services and sanitary sewer laterals. Due to the depth and nature of the storm sewer construction work on Brian Drive, the intersection of Brian Drive and Clematis Road will remain closed throughout the month of April 2023.

Reasons for the extended road closure are due to delays related to:

- Site specific work requiring certain weather conditions to complete the construction
- Unexpected site constraints and unanticipated conflicts with the installation of the shaft
- Material supply and distribution issues required to perform construction work

We know that this project has an impact on residents in the area. We sympathize and appreciate your patience.

Motorists are reminded to abide by traffic/construction signs posted in local areas to ensure the safe travel of all local road users, pedestrians, and cyclists. This project is part of the Council-approved 2020 Basement Flooding Protection Program to improve the water distribution system; renew our aging infrastructure and reduce the risk of sewer collapse or blockages that cause sewer backups and flooding.

WORK DETAILS

For this project, the contractor will:

- Excavate a tunnel shaft in order to access and install the new sewer system
- Replace any City-owned water service pipes or sewer laterals that do not meet City standards from the watermain or sewer to the private property line
- Restore all areas affected by construction and resurface the road/trench area
