### Grubbes Bridge Rehabilitation on Albion Road over the West Humber River

### Contract: 22ECS-BE-10BSE Start Date: November 2, 2022 Expected End Date: December 2023 NEW End Date: June 2024\*

\*Timeline is subject to change.

This notice provides an update on the rehabilitation of Grubbes Bridge on Albion Road over the West Humber River. Work on this project is currently behind schedule. This delay was caused by unforeseen weather and extended utility and third-party approvals. The City's contractor is working diligently to complete the remainder of the project. Due to these delays, the project end date has been revised to June 2024.

We know this project has an impact to all businesses and residents along Albion Road. We sympathize and appreciate your patience with the dust, noise, fencing and other inconveniences.

#### WORK STATUS TO DATE

To date, the following work has been completed:

- Installed traffic control at the bridge including cofferdam on the watercourse
- Demolition of the west side of the bridge including retaining wall, pier and abutment removals

### **REMAINING WORK**

In the coming months, the City's contractor will be completing the following work:

- Repair and reface the retaining walls, pier, and abutment walls including bearing replacements
- Replace the bridge superstructure including installation of new concrete girders and reconstruction of the concrete parapet walls, sidewalk, railings and approach slabs
- Replace the bridge waterproofing, asphalt surface and pavement markings
- Improve bridge approaches, road drainage and street lighting
