- 2. Claire Julia Dorothy Richards-Irwin** (Report No. 7779)
Applicant for an Entertainer Licence (Application No. C229969)

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the joint Proposed Resolution, on consent, as follows:

"Entertainer Licence will be issued, subject to the following conditions;

- (1) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the application may be cancelled;
- (2) Immediately upon being issued, Entertainer Licence will be placed on probation for a period of Two (2) year(s). Claire Julia Dorothy Richards-Irwin is advised that during the probationary period, MLS may make additional checks of any criminal and by-law charges and convictions against Claire Julia Dorothy Richards-Irwin and conduct other investigations, as appropriate, to assess Claire Julia Dorothy Richards-Irwin's compliance with the requirements of Chapter 545 of the Municipal Code and other applicable laws;

- (3) Prior to each of the next Two (2) renewal(s) of the licence, Claire Julia Dorothy Richards-Irwin must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at her own expense, an original up-to-date abstract of her Criminal Record and Judicial Matters Check;
- (4) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions including the charges currently before the court against Claire Julia Dorothy Richards-Irwin or any other concerns with respect to the conduct of the licensee, those matters and Report No. 7779 and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.”
