Virtual Trailer Drop-in Meetings for Sanitary and Storm Sewer Upgrades on Old Mill Drive and Catherine Street

Contract: 20ECS-LU-01FP Start Date: September 2021 New End Date: August 2023 *Timeline is subject to change.

This notice provides an update on the work to upgrade the storm and sanitary sewer system in your area to reduce surface and basement flooding and information on biweekly virtual trailer meetings for interested residents to attend and learn more about the progress of work.

Workers are currently continuing with ground improvement works to rescue the micro tunnel boring machine and proceed with storm sewer installation on Old Mill Drive to alleviate the flooding of basements in the area.

All remaining underground works and restoration of the tunnel shafts and parks will be completed by the end of August 2023. There is no structural risk to the surrounding infrastructure, buildings or roadway and the team will continue to ensure the safety of the community.

Traymore Park experienced overland flooding in early March due to a storm sewer surcharge caused by a blockage in the existing local storm sewer. The City is working on cleaning out the blockage and conducting investigations to resolve the issue. As a temporary solution, a by-pass pumping system is now in place to alleviate any future surcharge at this location. We apologize for any inconvenience and appreciate your patience as we complete this important work.

VIRTUAL TRAILER DROP-IN MEETINGS

Virtual trailer meetings will be held every two weeks, starting on April 27. The virtual trailer session offers residents an opportunity to drop-in online and meet with the project team to ask questions about the work that is happening. Councillor Perks will be in attendance.
