Start Date: Spring 2023

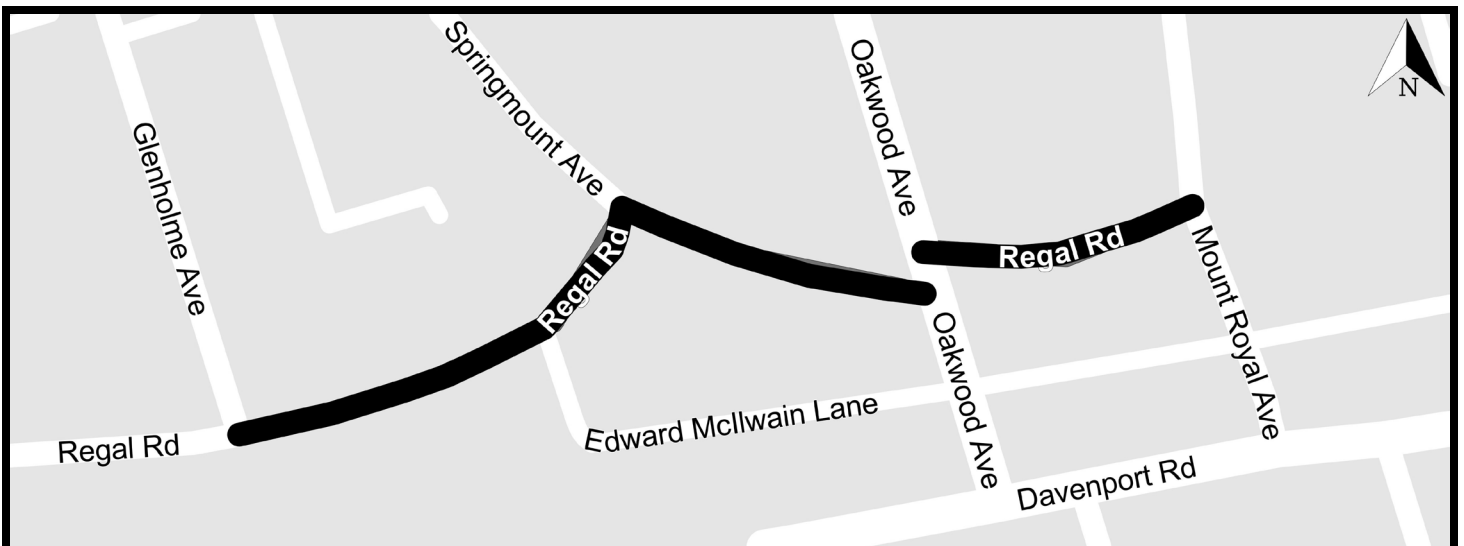

The City of Toronto is planning to resurface Regal Road from Mount Royal Avenue to Glenholme Avenue. Our inspection of the roadway has shown that needs repaving. Work will also include safety modifications to the intersection of Regal Road and Springmount Avenue.

Road resurfacing presents an opportunity to ensure that the road and intersection meet current standards for safety and accessibility. It also serves to achieve the mandate of the City's Vision Zero Road Safety Plan, adopted by City Council, which aims to reduce the potential for future traffic related injuries and fatalities on our streets.

WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark sidewalks and curbs requiring replacement and the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

	<p>Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the Project Manager listed below.</p>
	<p>Important information for owners of sprinkler systems / heated driveways and private landscaping features. Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard) to avoid damage.</p> <p>This includes items such as landscaping (plants and pavers), decorative objects, sprinkler systems or heated driveways.
