Watermain Replacement and Local Road Improvements on Wellington Street West

Contract: 22ECS-LU-04SU Start Date: August 2, 2022 End Date: July 2023 *Timeline is subject to change.

The City of Toronto's work to replace the watermain and the City-owned portion of substandard water services on Wellington Street West is progressing. To safely facilitate the road paving work and minimize impact to daytime traffic, nighttime construction work has been scheduled for:


- Evening of Monday May 22, Tuesday May 23 and Wednesday May 24 starting at 7 p.m. -Pavement marking work on Wellington Street West
- Tuesday, May 23 at 7 p.m. and will continue until the morning of Wednesday, May 24 at 7 a.m. and Wednesday, May 24 at 7 p.m. and will continue until the morning of Thursday, May 25 at 7 a.m.
- During the nightwork, the road will be closed except for local traffic only. Residents should expect construction noise in the immediate work zone.

Nighttime paving locations:

- Paving on Wellington Street West from Portland Street to Bathurst Street.
- Paving on Portland Street from Wellington Street West to Front Street.
- Pavement markings on Wellington Street W from Spadina Avenue to Bathurst Street.

We know this project has an impact to residents along Wellington Street West. We sympathize and appreciate your patience with the dust, noise, fencing and other inconveniences.

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WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION



Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.

 Nightwork is currently scheduled on Monday evening May 22, on Tuesday, May 23 at 7 p.m. to Wednesday, May 24 at 7 a.m. and on Wednesday, May 24 at 7 p.m. to Thursday, May 25 at 7 a.m.



Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users.

· Local traffic access will still be maintained.



Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

Driveway Access: The contractor will coordinate driveway access requirements and will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.



Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. This project will affect on-street parking. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated with no charge to the owner. Please call **416-808-2222** for its location.
