## Watermain Replacement and Local Road Improvements on Wellington Street West

**Contract: 22ECS-LU-04SU**  
**Start Date: August 2, 2022**

The City of Toronto’s work to replace the watermain and the City-owned portion of substandard water services on Wellington Street West is progressing. This is to provide an update on the notice that was distributed on April 19, regarding the westbound traffic closure on Wellington Street West from Spadina Avenue to Portland Street for road resurfacing work. **Due to delays resulting from inclement weather and ground conditions, the westbound traffic closure on Wellington Street West from Spadina Avenue to Portland Street has been extended until May 12.**

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

	<p><b>Work Hours:</b> Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b> Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Wellington Street West from Spadina Avenue to Portland Avenue will be closed to Westbound traffic until May 12.</b></li> <li>• <b>Eastbound traffic will still be maintained during the duration of this work</b></li> </ul> <p>This traffic restriction is required to allow work to safely proceed while mitigating extenuating traffic impacts expected with traditional two-way lane closures.</p>
	<p><b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p><b>Driveway Access:</b> The contractor will coordinate driveway access requirements and will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>



**Parking:** Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. This project will affect on-street parking. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated with no charge to the owner. Please call **416-808-2222** for its location.
