- 1. Muntazar Abd** (Report No. 7790)  
Applicant for a Tow Truck Driver's Licence (Application No. C245008)

**DECISION:**

Muntazar Abd requested an adjournment of this matter and Municipal Licensing and Standards agreed to the adjournment request.

- 2. Marek Bledy** (Report No. 7775)  
Applicant for a Refreshment Vehicle Driver Licence (Application No. C227080)

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the joint Proposed Resolution, originally signed on May 1 (Marek Bledy) and May 4, 2023 (by Municipal Licensing and Standards), as follows:

"Refreshment Vehicle Driver Licence be issued subject to the following conditions:

- (1) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the licence(s) may be cancelled;
- (2) Prior to each of the next **Two (2)** renewal(s) of the licence, MAREK BLEDY must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an original up-to-date abstract of his Criminal Record and Judicial Matters Check;

- (3) The Refreshment Vehicle Driver Licence will be placed on probation for a period of **Two (2) years**. MAREK BLEDY is advised that during the probationary period, MLS may make additional checks of any driving, criminal, and by-law charges and convictions against MAREK BLEDY and conduct other investigations, as appropriate, to assess MAREK BLEDY's compliance with the requirements of Chapter 545 of the Municipal Code and other applicable laws;
- (4) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions against MAREK BLEDY or any other concerns with respect to the conduct of the licensee, those matters and report no. 7775 and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.”
