Outbreak Preparedness Toolkit

Supplies and Resources Quest!

Time Required:	25 min
Target Audience:	IPAC Leads, Nurse Managers, Directors of Care, IPAC Champions, New hires (RNs, RPNs, PSWs)

Introduction

It is very important that we know where to access outbreak related supplies and who to contact if we identify that supplies and resources are getting low. This supplies and resources hunt activity will help us become familiar with our facility surroundings and where to quickly find supplies and resources. This way, all staff will be ready to implement additional outbreak precautions or testing required in the event of an outbreak. Let's get prepared!

Variations of this activity can be developed depending on the changing needs of the facilities.

Objectives

- Identify the locations of critical supplies and resources
- Identify missing/low in stock items and discuss plan for restocking

Instructions
