Dear Resident,

The City of Toronto is planning new sidewalk construction on the west side of Flint Road from 200 metres north of Supertest Road to the Finch Hydro Corridor Recreational Trail in 2023. This project presents an opportunity to incorporate changes that reflect the City's priorities for improved road safety and greater accessibility. As part of the planned work on Flint Road, we are notifying you about this planned work because it involves changes to the right-of-way in front of your property. Sidewalks are a fundamental requirement for an accessible city.

In accordance with City standards the sidewalk will be 2.1m metres wide adjacent to the existing curb. Existing parking and traffic operations will not be impacted by the new sidewalk. The sidewalk design minimizes the impact to items on the right-of-way in front of your property. We will contact you if any items need to be removed in order for the construction to proceed. Driveways, lawns and walkways that are impacted during construction will be restored at the completion of the road work.
