Watermain and Combined Sanitary Sewer Replacement on Canvarco Road from Laird Drive to 45 m east of Laird Drive

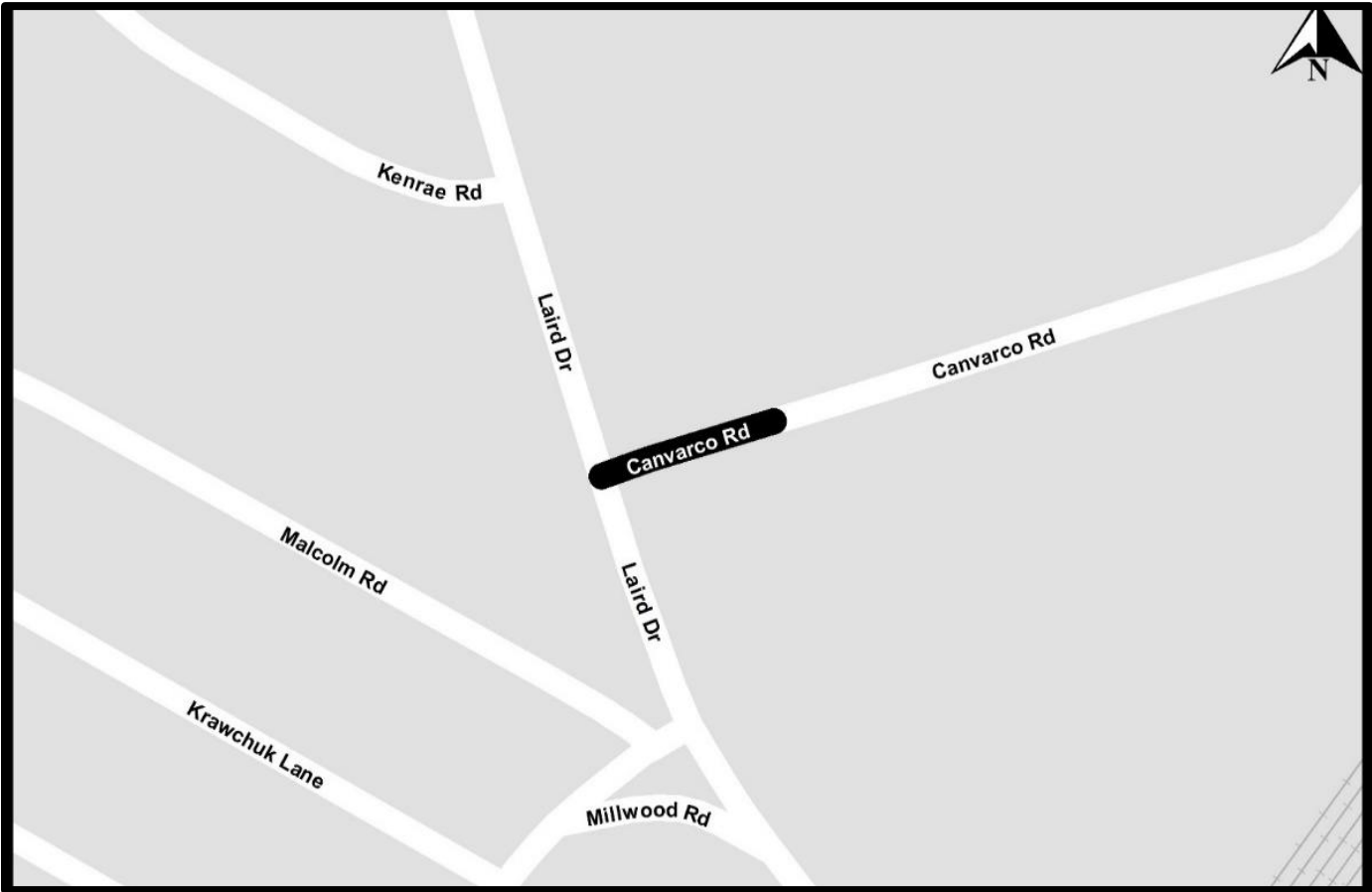

This notice provides an update on the replacement of the watermain and Combined Sanitary Sewer Replacement on Canvarco Road from Laird Drive to 45 m east of Laird Drive.

The watermain work on Canvarco is complete. The next phase of the project involves sewer replacement work, and is expected to begin on July 4, 2023. To minimize the traffic impact, the work will be carried out during a combination of day and night shifts. The contractor is permitted overnight work to reduce traffic disruptions during peak hours.

We know this project has an impact to all businesses and residents along Canvarco Road. We sympathize and appreciate your patience with the dust, noise, fencing and other inconveniences while we work to improve important City infrastructure.
