## Watermain and Combined Sanitary Sewer Replacement and Road Reconstruction on Wheeler Avenue from Juniper Avenue to Norway Avenue

This notice provides an update on the replacement of the watermain and combined sanitary sewer replacement and road reconstruction on Wheeler Avenue from Juniper Avenue to Norway Avenue. Due to inclement weather experienced over recent months, progress of the work has been delayed. Wheeler Avenue has been affected by multiple unexpected watermain breaks that required immediate attention, which further contributed to the delays. Please see above for new end date.
