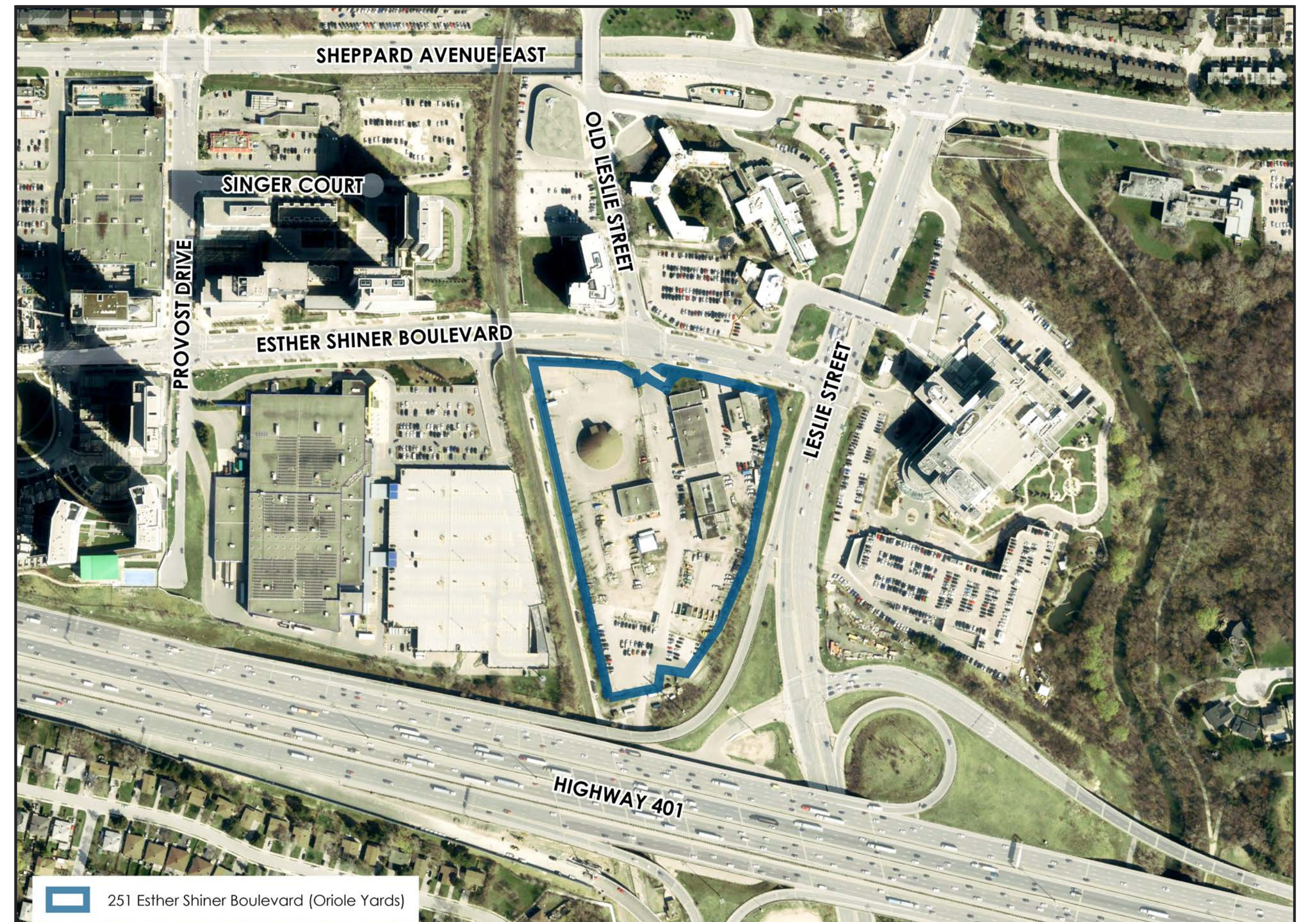


New Affordable Housing at 251 Esther Shiner Blvd (Oriole Yards)

The Oriole Yards at 251 Esther Shiner Boulevard will be the location of a City-led redevelopment through the Housing Now Initiative. 251 Esther Shiner Boulevard will include the development of new homes, with a proposal for affordable rental, market rental, and market ownership units. The redevelopment will also include a new public street, public park and retention of the existing Toronto Fire Station No. 116. Community engagement for this project is expected to begin in late 2023.



HousingTO 2020-2030 Action Plan

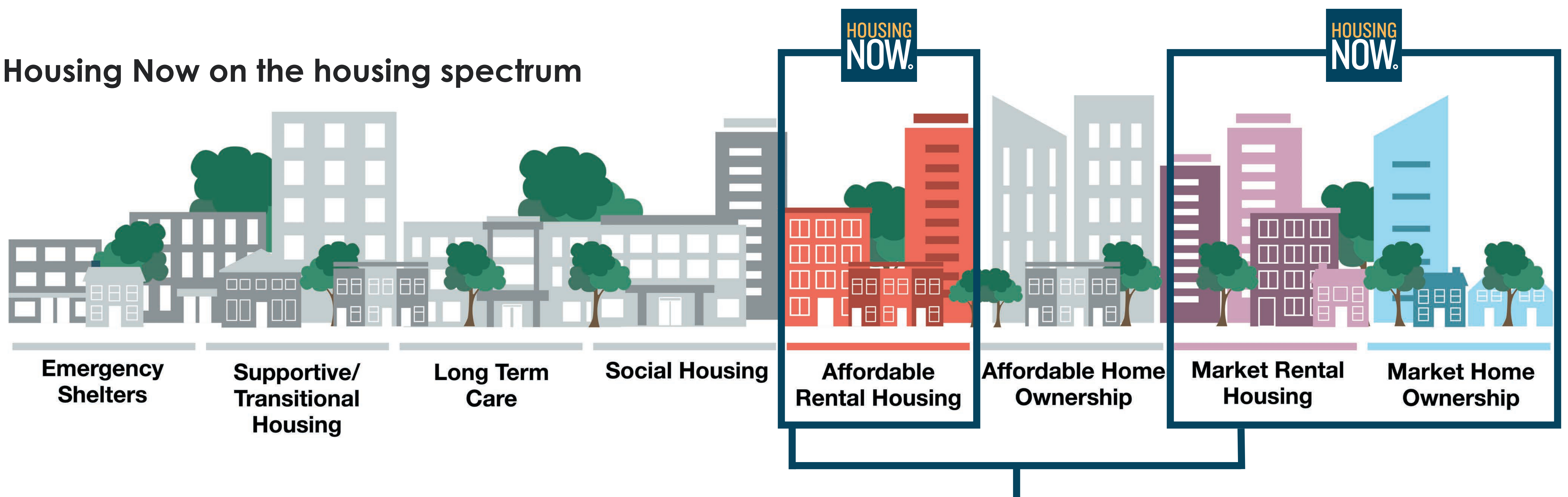
The City of Toronto is involved with providing funding for, and supporting construction of new housing. The HousingTO 2020-2030 Action Plan, adopted by City Council in December 2019, aims to ensure that the City is taking actions to advance a housing landscape that works for all Torontonians. The "Housing Spectrum" showcases the different housing options that exist in our City.

The HousingTO 2020-2030 Action Plan will address housing needs across the housing spectrum.

Housing Now is one component of this Plan and will provide affordable rental, market rental and market ownership housing options across the city, as seen below.

The proposed new housing at 251 Esther Shiner Blvd (Oriole Yards) is affordable rental, market rental and market ownership homes.

Proposed New Housing at 251 Esther Shiner Boulevard

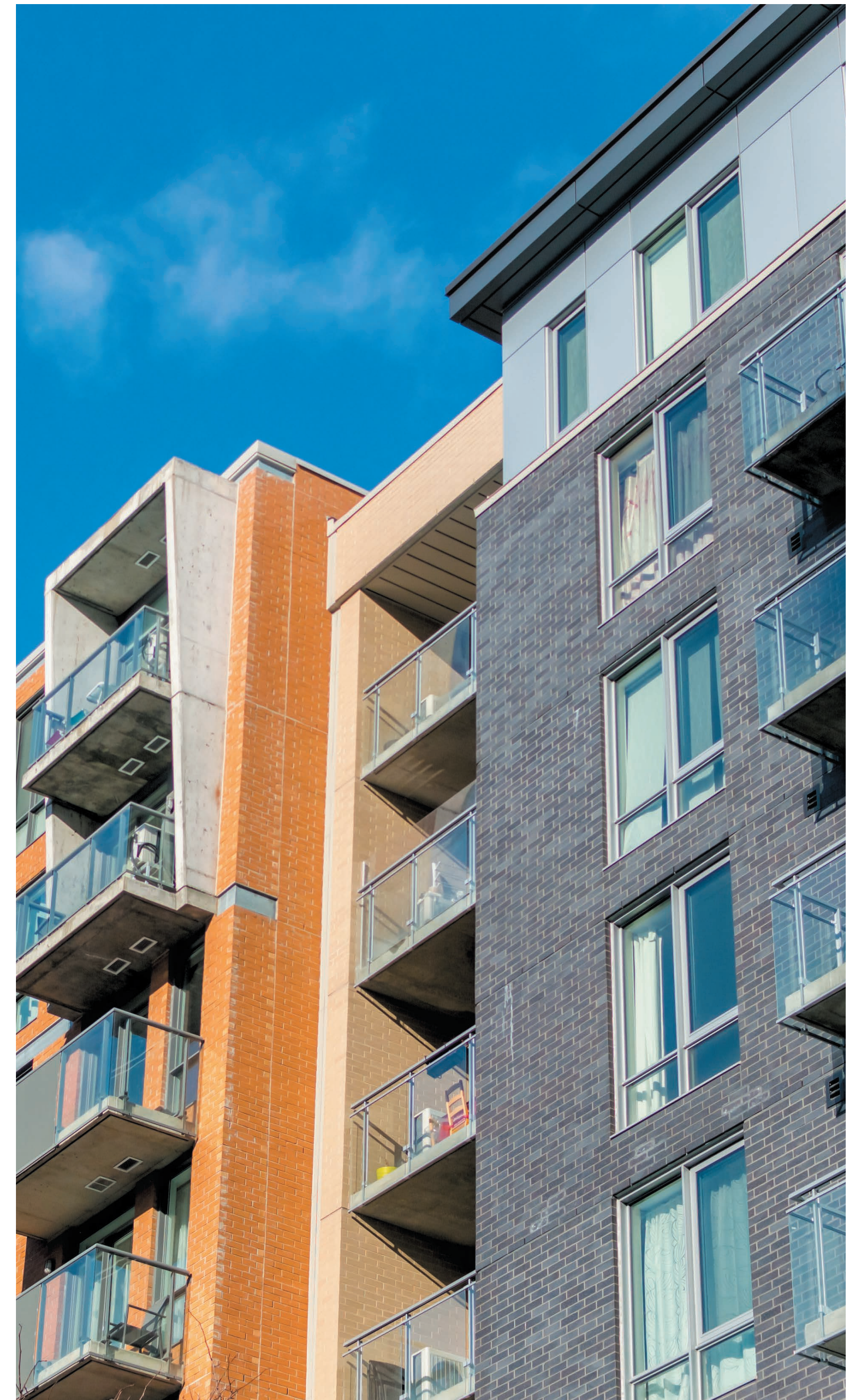
Access to New Housing Opportunities



The new affordable homes will be available to households meeting certain eligibility criteria (such as income).

The City, in collaboration with the selected housing provider, will ensure open and equitable access to the public for the affordable homes.

New opportunities will be advertised by the City and the selected development team in advance of the construction completion.
