St. Clair Avenue West under Metrolinx Rail Bridge Rehabilitation

Contract: 23ECS-BE-10BSE Start Date: September 2023, End Date: June 2024 *Timeline is subject to change.

The City of Toronto will rehabilitate the St. Clair Avenue West Bridge under Metrolinx Rail. This work will ensure that the bridge meets today's standards and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2023 Capital Works Program.

WORK DETAILS

The City's contractor will:

- Repair and refurbish the existing St. Clair Avenue West Bridge under Metrolinx Rail
- Reface concrete at deck, deck soffit, pier and top of pier footing
- Reconstruct ballast curbs, sidewalks, supporting ribs and concrete posts on top of bridge deck
- Remove existing ballast on east side of deck, waterproof deck, sidewalks and ballast curbs
- Concrete patch repair at deck top, soffit, abutment walls/ caps, retaining walls, pier caps
- Install new galvanized steel railings
- Reconstruct damaged concrete sidewalks and apply concrete sealer on bridge structure
- Reinstate electrical conduits, install new junction boxes, and street lightings
- Reconstruct new steel beam guiderail at southwest corner and concrete toe wall at northwest corner

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

• You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, Saturday 9 a.m. to 7 p.m., and during off-peak hours and on weekends as required.
	Due to Metrolinx's occupancy restrictions and daytime train schedules, there will be a period of time when work will need to be conducted overnight during Metrolinx's non-service window. Information about overnight work will be provided in future email updates once construction progresses. ÷	 Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Sidewalks under the bridge will remain open during each construction stage. Pedestrian detour signage will be posted. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

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8	Traffic Management : Road users should expect delays. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users.		
	 At least one traffic lane in each direction will be maintained on St. Clair Avenue West during construction. 		
	 Work will result in bus replacement on the 512 streetcar route starting as early as September 3, 2023. As of September 3, 2023, if travelling between Gunns Road and St Clair Station, customers board buses along St. Clair Avenue (curbside). The 33 Forest Hill and 126 Christie buses can be boarded on St Clair Ave. West in front of St Clair West Station main entrances. The extension of 47A Lansdowne will be discontinued as of Sep. 3, 2023. 		
	 At St Clair Station, customers can access 512 buses at the streetcar platform. 90 Vaughan bus service will be extended to Bathurst Station starting September 3, 2023.
