

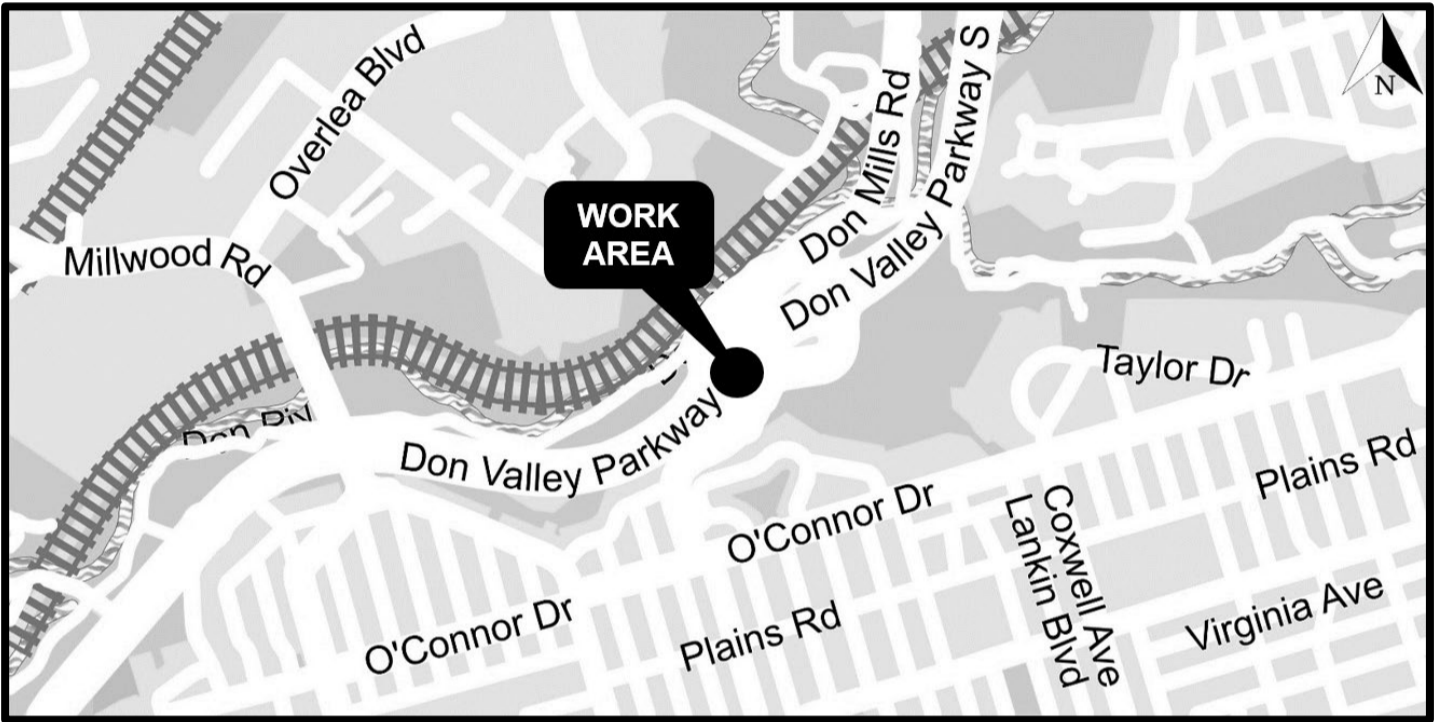

Don Mills Road Bridge Rehabilitation over the Don Valley Parkway

Contract: 23ECS-BE-12BSE
Start Date: September 5, 2023 End Date: November 2023
**Timeline is subject to change.*

The City of Toronto will rehabilitate the Don Mills Road Bridge over the Don Valley Parkway (DVP). This work will ensure that the bridge meets today’s standards and remains safe for road users into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2023 Capital Works Program.

WORK DETAILS

The City’s contractor will:





- Set up work areas and traffic control in the vicinity of the bridge
- Implement nightly lane and ramp closures on the Don Valley Parkway to create a safe work zone
- Clean and paint the existing structural steel on the bridge

Construction will take place in the following stages:

|  | <p>Work Hours: Work will take place at night from 11 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday to Friday. On weekends, the work may take place at night from 11 p.m. to 9 a.m.</p> |
|  | <p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there may be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>The pedestrian access area along the east side of Don Mills Road will be closed during the project.</p> |
|  | <p>Traffic Management: There will be nightly ramp and lane closures on the Don Valley Parkway during construction. Traffic in both directions will be maintained on Don Mills Road.</p> <p>Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on the DVP and on nearby main and side streets.</p> |
|  | <p>Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the Field Ambassador listed below.</p> |
