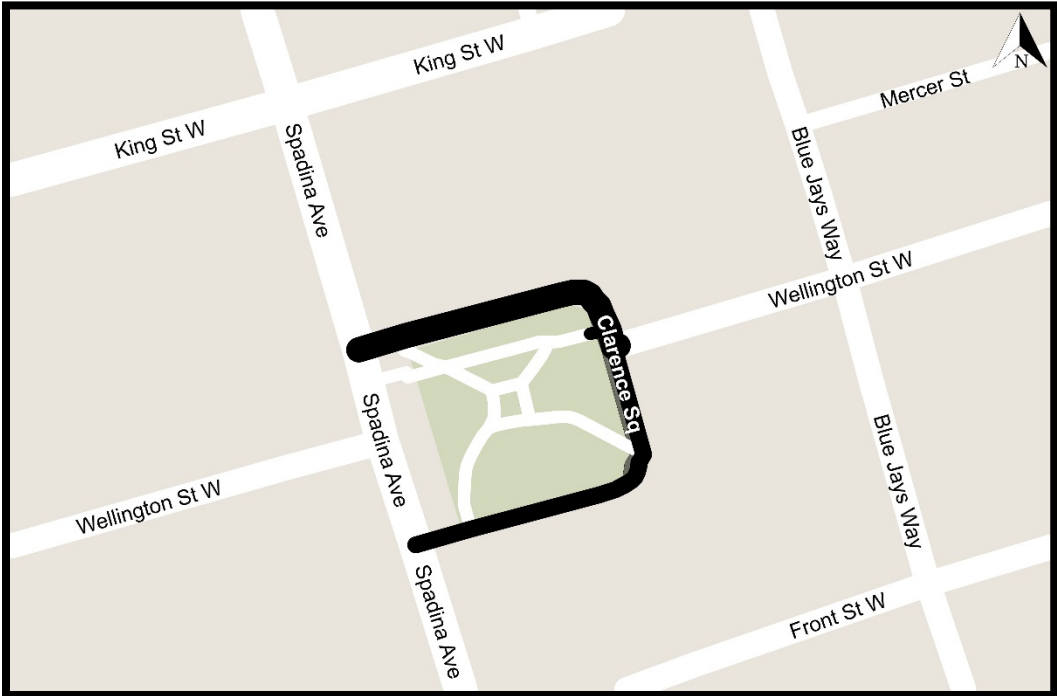
The City of Toronto’s work to replace the watermain and the City-owned portion of substandard water services on Clarence Square is almost complete. **To safely facilitate paving works and minimize impact to daytime traffic and service disruption, nighttime construction work has been scheduled on Clarence Square on the north and south leg of Clarence Square from Spadina Avenue to Spadina Avenue**

- On Wednesday, September 20 at 7 p.m. and will continue until the morning of Thursday, September 21 at 7 a.m.



Residents should expect construction noise in the immediate work zone. In the event of inclement weather or other delays to the work, the work will be deferred or extended to subsequent nights.



We know this project has an impact to residents and businesses along Wellington Street West. We appreciate your patience with the dust, noise, fencing and other inconveniences.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">On Wednesday, September 20 at 7 p.m. and will continue until the morning of Thursday, September 21 at 7 a.m.
	<p>Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Road closure is expected during this work on Clarence Square (north and south leg) and on Wellington Street West and Blue Jays Way. Local traffic access will still be maintained.

	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Driveway Access: The contractor will coordinate driveway access requirements and will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p>Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. This project will affect on-street parking. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated with no charge to the owner. Please call 416-808-2222 for its location.</p>
