

MATERIALS



Outside clay or old clay is not permitted and pottery tools are not provided. Students must bring their own tools or purchase them from Cedar Ridge (cash or cheque only).

POTTERY & CLAY COURSES & WORKSHOPS

POTTERY: BEGINNER 🥒 🏶




POTTERY: INTERMEDIATE 🥒 🏶

Refine techniques learned in beginner courses and improve your throwing and hand-building skills. Explore more complex forms and learn to make repetitive shapes. Gain basic knowledge of the kiln firing process and different glazing techniques with increased one-on-one attention from your instructor. This is a course for potters with intermediate/ advanced skills. It is not designed for beginner students. Students should be able to competently centre and throw a 2-lb cylinder or hand-build a 4-to-6-inch piece.

POTTERY: ADVANCED 🥒 🏶

Harness the pottery techniques covered in beginner and intermediate courses and improve your skills with more complex wheel work, hand-building and glazing. Learn the art of self-critique and discover how to advance your artistic practice. This is a course for potters with intermediate/advanced skills. It is not designed for beginner-level students. Students should be able to competently centre and throw a 3-lb cylinder or hand-build a 6-inch piece.

WHEEL WORK: INTERMEDIATE/ADVANCED 🥒 🏶



ADVANCED EXPLORATIONS IN POTTERY **

Explore and discover your personal style in this advanced-level class, designed to take your clay skills to the next level through challenging individualized projects. This class is not for beginners. Students should be able to competently centre and throw a 3-lb cylinder or hand-build a 6-inch piece before enrolling in this class.

SCULPTURE: BEGINNER 🥒 🏶

Uncover the fundamentals of clay sculpture in this course for hand-builders and sculptors. Each session begins with a short talk and demonstration about ceramic sculpture. Experiment with clay slabbuilding and figure modeling and create abstract sculptures that glisten when glazed.

PRINT TRANSFERS & SURFACE DESIGN ON POTTERY *

Learn how to transfer unique patterns, designs and images to pottery through various surface-decorating techniques. Explore carving, stamping and printing and create slip transfers through printing with underglaze. This class is not for beginners; it is for potters with intermediate skills. Students should be able to competently centre and throw a 1-lb cylinder or handbuild a 4-to-6-inch piece before enrolling in this class.

SLAB WORK & HAND BUILDING: BEGINNER 🥒

Discover the fundamentals of working with clay in this 8-week hand-building workshop. Learn how to use pottery tools and equipment like slab rollers. This course introduces students to greenware, bisqueware and glazeware processes from clay to pot as well as reclaiming techniques.

PRINT TRANSFERS ON POTTERY A

Explore the art of transferring images onto pottery in this 8-week workshop. Learn how to create slip transfers through printing with underglaze and create unique works as you decorate forms with handmade transfers. Students will make simple ceramic forms and be encouraged to explore new and unique works for their transferware. This course is not for beginners. Students must be able to completely centre and throw a 1-lb cylinder or hand-build a 4-to-6-inch piece before enrolling in this workshop.

Students taking pottery courses must purchase clay from Cedar Ridge Creative Centre for \$40 per bag. This includes glazing, firing and technician costs. Pottery tools are not provided. Students must bring their own tools or purchase them from Cedar Ridge. All sales are cash or cheque only.

VISUAL ARTS COURSES

LANDSCAPE PAINTING: ALL LEVELS 🥒

Learn how to paint beautiful landscapes and gain in-depth knowledge on illustrating natural scenes that feature mountains, valleys, trees, rivers and forests. Your instructor will provide easy-to-follow instructions on composition, colour theory and perspective in nature.

WILDLIFE DRAWING & PAINTING: BEGINNER/ INTERMEDIATE A

Examine animal body structures and explore the fundamentals of line, texture, highlights and shadows to produce realistic depictions of wild animals. Your instructor will explain related historical and contemporary artworks, using slideshows to provide a rich source of inspiration.

URBAN LANDSCAPE PAINTING: ALL LEVELS *🔊*

Discover how to capture the dynamic and unique aspects of urban landscapes. Explore traditional and contemporary approaches to painting, learning the fundamentals of the genre such as perspective, light and form, use of colour, paint application and composition.

BOTANICAL DRAWING & PAINTING: ALL LEVELS *🔊*

Capture the beauty of the natural world with precision as you develop techniques needed to re-create intricate detail, natural colour and convincing form. Learn to identify plants as you explore composition, design, colour-mixing, light and shadows using pencils, fine-liner pens, markers, watercolor and acrylic.

WATERCOLOURS: BEGINNER A

Explore the creative possibilities of mixing watercolours with liquids or other mediums to create delicate textures and learn essential techniques, including wet-dry and dry-brush. Your instructor will provide demonstrations and in-depth discussions about watercolour techniques, colour theory, and colour-mixing.

WATERCOLOURS: INTERMEDIATE/ADVANCED 🥒 🗱

Develop a critical eye while experimenting with painting wet-in-wet, pouring colour, using multiple washes and learning to develop brush work techniques. Gain new skills in the areas of design and composition, as well learn the roles that colour, texture and light play when creating with waterbased paint.

PORTRAIT DRAWING & PAINTING: ALL LEVELS *7*

Discover the principles of portraiture and unlock your ability to draw expressive facial details from photographs. Your instructor will break down complex technical concepts with step-by-step exercises to help you capture distinct features and personalities using line, form, light and shadows.

INTERMEDIATE/ADVANCED PAINTING 🥒 🏶

Hone your painting skills through studies of brushwork styles, colour layering techniques, natural textures and narrative symbolism. Explore painting as a method to convey personal memories and experiences from the mundane to the extraordinary.

BEGINNER DRAWING & PAINTING 🥒 🏶

Discover and learn the fundamentals of drawing and painting. Through focused studio practices on understanding light and shadow, mark making, basics of composition, and colour theory, explore the cornerstones for creating captivating artwork.

STILL LIFE IN ACRYLICS **

Learn how to translate three-dimensional objects into a two-dimensional still-life painting and explore how colour theory and mixing can illuminate forms on the painting surface. Students may bring items from home to inspire the design and assembly of their work.

ANATOMY FOR ARTISTS 🥭

Study the relationship between form and function by drawing the human skeleton and observing the muscle groups that connect the skeletal system. In this course, students will visually dissect physical structures and learn how bodily proportions and limitations shape depictions of the human form.

DRAWING THE STILL LIFE A

Learn how to compose a still life from threedimensional objects and determine the values of black and white drawing as you explore various drawing techniques. Students will build a shadow box of personal items to draw.

EXPERIMENTAL MARK MAKING: DRAWING, WATERCOLOUR & COLLAGE 🥒

Explore a variety of techniques to create original, abstract drawings and paintings. Investigate the patterns and textures found in natural and fabricated objects and experiment with expressive marks using pencils, pens and non-traditional tools.

SKETCHBOOK EXPLORATIONS

Loosen up, get creative and work freely without fear of messing up while discovering new drawing and painting techniques. Explore color mixing and experiment with new ways of using pencils, charcoal, pens, watercolour, acrylic, ink and collage. Learn how to structure a regular art practice and fill your sketchbook with explorations to inspire future creations.

MIXED MEDIA: WORKING ON CREATIVE BACKGROUNDS 🥭 🏶

Learn to create original artworks that merge two cohesive layers. Create loose process-based backgrounds using watercolors, inks and acrylics, then experiment with drawings, paintings and materials that add another layer of interest to your work.

CREATIVE ILLUSTRATION 🥒 🏶

Study creative illustration methods and visual styles with an emphasis on storytelling. From conceptual sketches to detailed renderings made with colored pencils, watercolor, gouache, and acrylics, your instructor will take you through the fundamental theories of creative illustration.



Mixed Media Creative Backgrounds

INTRODUCTION TO DRAWING 🥒 🏶



Develop foundational drawing skills and constructive sketchbook practices with guidance from a gualified instructor. Discover how to apply established drawing methodologies, including the seven elements of art, and refine your observational skills while drawing from life, photos and your imagination.

PORTFOLIO STUDIO: CREATIVE & PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT A *

Develop and create a cohesive series of original artworks that are exhibition-ready. Using a preferred medium and artistic approach, students will produce a body of work that share a formal and thematic relationship. Learn to write an artist statement and biography, exhibit artwork and develop strategies to evolve your art practice. This course culminates in a student exhibition in the Cedar Ridge Gallery.



Meet the instructor

Eric Petitti is an artist and educator with a Master of Fine Art in Painting and Drawing from the San Francisco Art Institute. An experienced studio art instructor, Eric meticulously crafts drawings, paintings and sculptures that use

traditional western illustrative techniques to create art that blends fact-base elements with fictional storytelling. Eric is a new instructor at Cedar ridge, teaching Acrylic Painting, Exploring Composition, Figurative Painting and Portfolio Studio. Eric also teaches at the University of Toronto, Scarborough, and McMaster University.

EXPLORING COMPOSITION THROUGH MIXED MEDIA 🥒 🏶

Learn foundational skills to design works that communicate their intentions using mixed media and various compositional approaches. Develop and evolve your work through a series of creative explorations that examine formal art and design principles.

INTRODUCTION TO FIGURATIVE PAINTING 🥒 🏶




Explore various techniques for painting the human figure and incorporate figurative elements into your work. Using acrylic paints primarily, learn how to establish proportions, model forms, mix colours and paint from direct observation and reference materials. Students will study contemporary and historical painting practices and explore new possibilities for figurative painting.

ACRYLIC PAINTING: METHODS & MATERIALS 🥭 🏶

Unleash the creative potential of acrylic painting and gain experience with heavy body acrylics, material management, mixing values and colours and experimenting with various acrylic painting techniques. Demonstrations, discussions and examinations of historical and contemporary painting approaches will allow students to expand the notion of what painting can be and inspire new expressive possibilities.

BLOCK PRINTING


Discover the fundamentals of block printing in this hands-on class and learn techniques to create unique designs and patterns. Students will learn to carve stamp blocks and explore the art of printing on various materials.

INTRODUCTION TO AIRBRUSH A



INTRODUCTION TO MOSAIC ART 🥒 🗱

Discover the ancient art of mosaics while embracing Picassiette, a mosaic style that incorporates pieces of broken ceramics (plates, dishes, cups, tiles) and found objects. Learn fundamental practices and work with tools, materials and surfaces commonly used when creating mosaics. Students are encouraged to bring old or broken ceramic dishes to the first class, along with a sketch pad, pencil and eraser. This workshop requires an additional \$20 material fee, payable to the instructor.

INTRODUCTION TO GRAPHIC DESIGN 🥒 🏶



Discover the world of graphic design and its numerous applications and embark on projects that use typography and other design elements. Your instructor will teach you how to combine twodimensional images and text with a focus on design principles, function and aesthetics.



Learn the fundamentals of urban landscape painting by capturing the dynamic aspects of Toronto. Explore traditional and contemporary approaches with easyto-follow instructions on perspective, light and form, colour use, paint application and composition.

GROUP OF SEVEN EXPLORATION **



Explore landscape painting through the eyes of famous Canadian artists known as the Group of Seven in the four-week course. Learn techniques used by Thomson, Carr, Lismer and Casson, and break down their command of form, shape and colour to create surreal and exuberant landscapes in this distinct style.

COLOUR EXPLORATIONS **



Gain in-depth knowledge of colour harmony and theory in this 4-week workshop. Examine the Johannes Itten colour wheel and learn to easily mix colours using primaries, tertiaries, tints, tones and shades. Students will learn tricks to give the illusion of light and shadow to enhance the depth and luminosity of their paintings.

BLACK HISTORY MONTH COMMUNITY WORKSHOPS

ARTMAKING FOR BLACK WELLBEING & STRESS RELIEF *

African/ Caribbean/ Black identifying community members are invited to explore self care in this free 2-hour Arts in Health community workshop facilitated by Belinda Ageda. Belinda has dedicated years of research into wellness, historical impacts on the Black body/mind and the effective use of art and mindfulness techniques, measured against her own lived experience as a Black woman in North America. In this workshop, you will learn how to foster creative exploration and mental wellbeing through mapping exercises and expressive and contemplative drawing, as well as group discussion. Even learn how to use your cellphone for stress management! Two sessions available.



Meet the instructor Belinda Ageda (she/her) is an experienced Arts in Health professional, who has delivered artsbased wellness workshops for over 15 years.

ABSTRACT LANDSCAPES **

Take a fresh and creative approach to painting by tapping into and developing your intuitive style. This workshop teaches students how to abstract landscape elements through stimulating exercises that foster a unique painterly response.

FIBRE ARTS WORKSHOPS

INTRODUCTION TO WEAVING 🥒 🏶



Learn the basics of weaving and finishing techniques on a floor loom in this introductory class. Find out how to make cloth from varn and dress your loom to wind the warp. Projects include a small wall hanging, table runner, rag rug or scarf. Yarn bundles range from \$40 to \$80 (depending on the project) and must be purchased separately.



Fibre Arts

WEAVING EXPLORATION 🥒 🏶

Design, weave and finish a hand-made cloth in this 5-week workshop which covers, how to select suitable varns for specific weaving projects, how to calculate materials before set-up, how to read weaving drafts for patterns and how to finish your projects off the loom with wet and hand-stitched techniques. Refresh your knowledge on how to warp and dress a loom and how to customize weaving structures and techniques to your project.

This workshop caters to weavers of all levels with knowledge of how to set up their weaving looms and weave basic structures. Students can bring a proposal for an intermediate project to get guidance on or pick from one of many project-based patterns. Projects include shawls or ponchos, rugs, wallhanging art, linens and scarfs. Students can bring their yarns or purchase a yarn bundle to make their project. A variety of fibres are available for purchase ranging from \$40 to \$100, depending on the project.

There is a loom rental fee of \$30 for all students to be paid at the main office, cash or cheque only.

Paint with yarn in this two-day workshop exploring the art of punch needle rug hooking. Create colourful punch needle rugs inspired by the painting, Tulips, by Nova Scotian folk artist Maud Lewis. No experience is necessary. This workshop requires an additional \$40 material fee, payable to the instructor.



Meet the instructor



Explore the basics of yarn dyeing in this one-day workshop. Discover the tools and techniques and dye six skeins of 100% Canadian wool using weak acid dyes. This workshop requires an additional \$30 material fee, payable to the instructor.

COURSES & WORKSHOPS FOR CHILDREN, YOUTH & FAMILIES

CREATIVE CLAY (7-10 YRS) 🥒 🏶

Explore the possibilities of creating with clay and learn basic pottery techniques such as pinching, coiling, slab building and glazing. Each project stimulates the imagination while developing pottery skills.

WHEEL THROWING (11-13 YRS) A *

Have fun getting a little messy as you learn all the steps to making a pot on the potter's wheel in this 5-week workshop. Discover how to trim and glaze your wheel-thrown pots for a spectacular finished creation.

WHEEL THROWING (14-17 YRS) 🥒 🏶

Learn to make a pot using the potter's wheel in this fun-filled 5-week workshop. Discover the technique of kneading clay, then learn to centre and throw on the wheel. Make a pot from start to finish, learning trimming and glazing techniques to create beautiful functional dishes.

CARTOONING (8-13 YRS) 🥭 🏶

Combine a love of drawing and storytelling and acquire the knowledge and skills to create a comic book with original cartoon characters - from storyboard to finished product. This course includes projects on comic strips, character study, poster art and seasonal cartoons.

PAINT LIKE THE MASTERS (7-13 YRS)

Each week learn about the life and work of a different world-famous artist. Then create your own masterpiece inspired by that week's feature artist. Art history and different art techniques will enrich your understanding and appreciation of art.

MIX IT UP! (7-13 YRS) 🥒

Get those creative juices flowing and learn to make beautiful one-of-a-kind artwork. Explore different art mediums, such as painting, printmaking, collage, watercolour and photography in this multifaceted course.

POTTERY MIXED MEDIA (7-10 & 11-13 YRS) 🥒 🏶

Learn about different types of art media and create clay-based masterpieces that may include decorative boxes, wind chimes, animal figurines, jewelry, mixed media paintings with glazed clay and more.

YOUNG PAINTERS STUDIO (7-13 YRS) 🥒 🏶

Experiment with painting styles like abstract, impressionism and realism, and develop new technical skills in acrylic, watercolour and ink. Learn the art of composition through self-expression, from portraits to still-life on various surfaces.

Get ready for Halloween and discover the ghostly paintings of Edvard Munch with your child. Learn how different colours work together and how to mix them to create new colours. Inspired by Munch's masterpiece, The Scream, students will bring their paintings eerily to life. Bring a picture of yourself screaming to collage into your painting. Both child and adult must register separately.
