

# **Beechgrove Drive Culvert Replacement** over West Hill Watercourse

Contract: 23ECS-BE-09BSE Start Date: October 2023 End Date: June 2024 \*Timeline is subject to change.

The City of Toronto is replacing the culvert at Beechgrove Drive over the West Hill Watercourse. This work will ensure that the culvert meets today's standards and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2023 Capital Works Program.

## **WORK DETAILS**

The City's contractor will:

- Earth excavate and backfill.
- Remove and replace the existing elliptical culvert with a new concrete culvert, and waterproofing.
- Reconstruct culvert inlet and outlet.
- Reconstruct retaining walls.
- Reconstruct steel beam guide rails.
- Reconstruct the sidewalk, boulevard, asphalt pavement within the proposed work area.

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.



Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.



Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

- Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout construction with a minimum of one sidewalk opened throughout construction.
- Pedestrians will be required to cross the road at the nearest existing crosswalk or the temporary crosswalk installed during construction to access the open sidewalk.

**Traffic Management**: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users.

- Traffic on Beechgrove Drive will maintain two lanes, one lane for each direction, during all stages of the work.
- Motorists are advised to follow temporary lane marking for safe passage through the construction area.



Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the **Field Ambassador** listed below.



**TTC Impacts:** Some TTC stops along Beechgrove Drive may be impacted during the work. Signage will be erected to direct bus users to temporary bus stop locations. Visit ttc.ca for accurate schedule information.
