## Letter of Undertaking

to the Chief Building Official of the City of Toronto

**WHEREAS** Sentence B - 9.14.6.1. of Ontario Regulation 350/06, as amended, made under the authority of the Building Code Act, requires that the building shall be located and the building site graded so that water will not accumulate at or near the building and will not adversely affect adjacent properties.

**THEREFORE**, the Owner, being the person who intends to construct or have a building constructed, hereby warrants that a "Grading Consultant" shall be retained to assure compliance with the requirements of Ontario Regulation 332/12 and any lot grading criteria or guidelines provided by the City of Toronto and that:

- 2. The "Grading Consultant" must issue a final Grading Certificate to the City of Toronto upon completion of the final grading.
