Road Reconstruction on Military Trail from Ellesmere Road to Highcastle Road

Contract: 19ECS-TI-105LR Start Date: February 2022 NEW Work resuming: Week of September 25 NEW End Date: Fall 2023/Spring 2024

The road reconstruction project on Military Trail has experienced a significant delay due to modifications required to the slopes and grades of the roadway.

Over the past several months, City staff have been collaborating closely with the contractor to address these issues and establish a viable plan to rectify them, ultimately ensuring the safe reopening of the road for public use. A solution has now been identified, and the contractor will commence work on site the week of September 25.

The contractor will carry out re-grading, curb adjustments and road repaving. Additionally, they will be working to activate the new street lighting while the road work is being carried out. We appreciate your patience and understanding as we work to complete this essential project.

The anticipated timeline for completion of this project is approximately eight weeks. This estimate is subject to potential adjustments based on site conditions and weather. Asphalt work, in particular, is very weather-dependent as both rain and low temperatures have a significant impact on the quality and durability of the road. While there is the potential for delays, we anticipate being able to reopen the road later this year, with some final work and restoration to be completed in the spring of 2024.
