

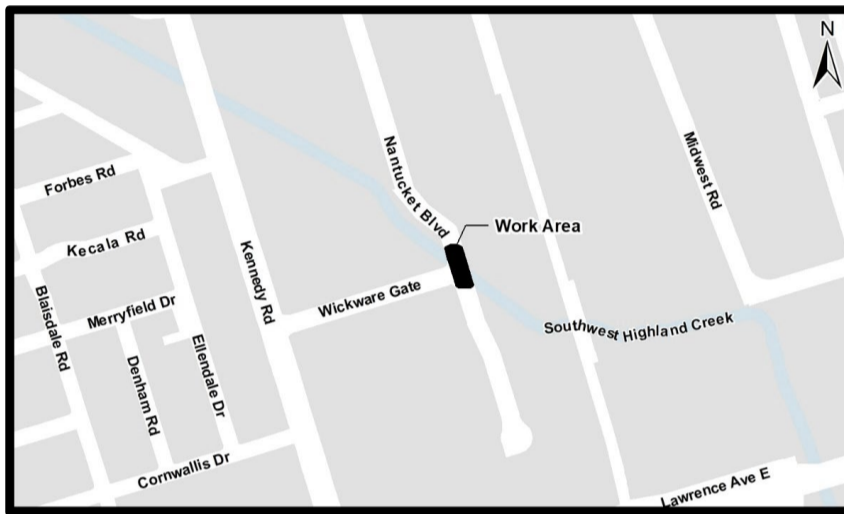

Nantucket Boulevard Culvert Rehabilitation over West Highland Creek

Contract: 23ECS-BE-09BSE

The City of Toronto is rehabilitating the culvert at Nantucket Boulevard over the West Highland Creek. This work will ensure that the culvert meets today’s standards and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2023 Capital

WORK DETAILS

The City’s contractor will:

- Repair and refurbish the existing Nantucket Culvert over West Highland Creek
- Patch repair the concrete footing stems
- Apply structural spray liner
- Replace the asphalt pavement as required
- Replace curb and gutter, grass boulevards, and chain-link fence on the retaining walls

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Traffic on Nantucket Boulevard will be on narrower lanes immediately south of Wickware Gate.
	<p>Parking: This project will affect on-street parking. Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated with no charge to the owner. Please call 416-808-2222 for its location.</p>
	<p>Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the Field Ambassador listed below.</p>
