West Humber Sanitary Trunk Sewer Rehabilitation

Contract: 21ECS-LU-07TT Expected Start Date: September 2022 Expected End Date: June 2023 NEW End Date: October 20, 2023

*Timeline is subject to change.

This notice provides an update on the rehabilitation of a section of the West Humber Sanitary Trunk Sewer (STS) from Humber Gate Park to Esther Lorrie Park. The sewer is located mainly along the West Humber Trail. The sanitary trunk sewer is an underground pipe that collects wastewater from sewers and delivers it to wastewater facilities for treatment. Work on this project is currently behind schedule. This delay was caused by additional emergency work due an unforeseen condition of the incoming sideline sewers that needed immediate attention.

We know this project has an impact to all businesses and residents along the West Humber Trail, from Humber Gate Park to Esther Lorrie Park. We appreciate your patience with the dust, noise, fencing and other inconveniences.



WORK STATUS TO DATE

- The emergency work is completed
 - The trunk sewers' rehab work is currently being performed and has been mostly completed.

REMAINING WORK

• The contractor will restore work zone and resurface the affected locations on the trail by October 20, 2023 (weather permitting for new asphalt)

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.



Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m.to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.

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Construction Update 1

	Sewer Service Disruptions: If the sanitary sewer service from your property requires a disruption to complete repairs the contractor will provide at least 24-hour advance notice. During sanitary sewer service disruptions, you will be advised to limit your water use.
÷	Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.
Ŀ	Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the Project Manager listed below.
	Parks and Trails: Due to the nature of this work a section of the West Humber trail and Esther Lorie Park will be affected. Sections of the park, fields and trail will be fenced off and closed for public safety. Signs will be posted. All areas of the park and trail affected by construction will be restored.
GTO	Cyclists: If travelling along the trails, please follow the detour signs in the active work zones.
	Restoration: The construction work area will be restored with sod, concrete and/or asphalt where required. Lawn seeding and/or laying of sod will be done as needed during ideal growing seasons only - in the spring (April to June) and fall (September to October).
