The City of Toronto's watermain replacement and road improvement work on Wellington Street West, Portland Street and other local streets is progressing. Due to unforeseen field conditions and inclement weather, construction is now anticipated to be complete by September 30, 2023.

The contractor has:


- Completed the watermain installation and water service connections on:
 - Stewart Street from Bathurst Street to Portland Street
 - Portland Street from Front Street West to Queen Street West
 - Wellington Street West from Bathurst Street to Draper Street
 - Windsor Street from Wellington Street West to Front Street West
 - Wellington Street West from Strachan Avenue to Bathurst Street
 - Morrison Street from Adelaide Street to the south limit
 - Wellington Street West from Clarence Square to John Street
- Completed Bikeway pavement markings Wellington Street from
 - Strachan Avenue to Niagara Street, on Wellington Street West and
 - Spadina Avenue and from Clarence Square to Blue Jays Way
- Completed permanent road base restoration at the above noted locations

REMAINING WORK

The contractor will:

- Complete the watermain and water service connections on:
- Clarence Square from Spadina Avenue to Spadina Avenue and
- Remove and replace concrete sidewalks and curbs impacted by construction
- Restore boulevards and driveways impacted by construction
- Resurface the portions of the road impacted by construction
- Complete permanent road base restoration

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WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

	Work Hours : Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.	
8	Traffic Management : Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users.	
	 Traffic within the immediate work zone may be reduced to one lane. TTC Flag person will be present on-site to coordinate operations of the streetcars 	
	TTC Service: This project may affect travel times on the 510 Spadina Streetcars. Visit ttc.ca for accurate schedule information.	
÷	Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.	
	There will be temporary restrictions at the crosswalk within the workzone	
	Driveway Access: The contractor will coordinate driveway access requirements and will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.	
(\mathbb{R})	Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. This project will affect on-street parking. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated with no charge to the owner. Please call 416-808-2222 for its location.
