Road Reconstruction/Road Resurfacing on Canongate Trail from Sanwood Boulevard to Purcell Square

Start Date: May 1st, 2023 Expected End Date: September 6, 2023



This notice provides an update on Road Reconstruction/Road Resurfacing on Canongate Trail. Work on this project is currently behind schedule. **Our contractor will be returning to the site on Wednesday October 4 to start excavation on Canongate Trail.** Work will be completed in four stages; residents should expect local daytime road closures and restricted access to their driveways for short periods of time during each stage of work. Closed roads will be reopened in the evening after daily construction. See below for work staging details.

The Project Team anticipate that all stages of work will be completed by December 2023 weather dependent. Future construction updates will be posted as work progresses. We know this project has an impact to all residents along Canongate Trail and we appreciate your patience as we complete this road reconstruction project.

MAP OF WORK AREA




LOCAL ROAD CLOSURES DURING CONSTRUCTION


- Please be advised of upcoming street closures due to construction on Canongate Trail. Each
 construction stage is expected to last for 2-3 weeks, road closures will start from 7 am to 7pm
 daily, Monday to Friday.
- The road will reopen at the end of construction activities each day. Resident should be advised
 that there will be times when the road is reopened in the evenings with only granular paving on
 the road and ongoing construction on the curb and gutter.
- Only emergency vehicles will maintain access on Canongate Trail throughout the construction period. Additionally, the contractor will provide advance notice, if residents will lose access to their driveways at any time. We recommend parking your cars on sidestreets during this time to prevent any conflicts.
- Please refer to the maps below that indicate the construction areas for each stage of work.




Stage 1 (Starting October 4, 2023) Closure from Kelvin Grove Avenue to Holmbush Crescent




Stage 2: Approximately 2-3 weeks after, Closure from Holmbush Crescent to New Forest Sq



Stage 3: Approximately 2-3 weeks, closure from New Forest Sq to Elmfield Crescent



Stage 4: Approximately 2-3 weeks, closure from Elmfield Crescent to Purcell Square



WORK STATUS TO DATE

The City's contractor has:

- Completed all catch basin relocations
- Partial Road Resurfacing on Canongate Trail From Sanwood Blvd to Kelvin Grove Ave
- Sidewalk State of good repair from Sanwood Blvd to Kelvin Grove Ave
- Partial Curb and Gutter State of Good repair from Sanwood Blvd to Kelvin Grove Ave
- Replaced the City-owned part of any water service pipes that do not meet City standards, from the watermain to the private property line

REMAINING WORK

The contractor will complete:



- road resurfacing on Canongate Trail From Sanwood Blvd to Kelvin Grove Ave
- road reconstruction on Canongate Trail From Kelvin Grove Ave to Purcell Sq
- · Sidewalk and curb construction
- Restore driveways and other areas impacted by construction

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.



Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m.to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.

During school: Construction will pause between the times of 8:15 am - 9am, and 3:15 pm to 4 pm.



Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents.



Kennedy Public School: Road users in the area are reminded to use caution when travelling through a school zone. Please be mindful of pedestrians when navigating through a construction zone. Expect the unexpected. Children may cross the street at the wrong place, run into traffic or ride a bike in front of a vehicle without warning.

- Please allocate additional time for student drop off. School zones are busy places with many children walking and getting dropped off.
- Drive slowly, pay attention and watch for pedestrians.
- Please take note of upcoming street closures in the vicinity. If you're dropping off school children, be aware of these closures and plan your routes accordingly.



On-Site Communication: There are times when contractors need to communicate with homeowners about what is happening on-site. This could be about driveway access, water shut offs, pre-construction inspections, and site restoration work (landscaping, installing pavers etc.). Contractor's staff will be identifiable by their high-visibility company branded clothing. If you need to speak with staff on the construction site, please ask for the Site Inspector.



Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. The contractor will be notifying residents 24 hours before of any driveway restrictions. Driveway restrictions will occur between 7 am to 7 pm. Please use side streets for parking during this time.



Pedestrians: The work may require temporary sidewalk restrictions, however any necessary sidewalk closures will alternate in each direction to ensure pedestrian access is maintained during construction.



Parking: This project will affect on-street parking. Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated with no charge to the owner. Please call 416-808-2222 for its location.





Parking Violation Notices: Please ensure you park in a legal parking spot at all times. If parking enforcement is called to a street, officers must issue a yellow parking violation notice (ticket) to vehicles in violation of parking by-laws. If you receive a yellow notice during this construction work, please do one of the following within 15 days of the notice date in order to avoid additional fines or records being kept of non-payment:

- 1. Pay the parking violation (follow instructions on the back of the notice) or
- 2. File a Parking Violation Dispute with the City online, by mail, or in person (follow instructions on the back of the notice). As part of the dispute process, you may include the construction notice and/or other documentation related to parking impacts resulting from construction.

If you do not have a copy of the Construction Notice, please contact 311 to request a copy.

Please note: Violation notices cannot be cancelled if vehicles are parked in illegal parking spots (i.e. in front of a fire hydrant or in No Parking zones).

In an effort to reduce ticketing due to construction, please exercise patience with neighbours who are experiencing construction impacts and may need to temporarily park on your street.



Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.
