

The City of Toronto will replace the watermain and the City-owned portion of substandard water services on Progress Avenue from Kennedy Road to 120 metres east of Kennedy Road, and from 160 metres west of Midland Avenue to 40 metres west of Midland Avenue; and the watermain replacement and road resurfacing on Glamorgan Avenue from Kennedy Road to Dundalk Drive.

Work on Progress Avenue and Glamorgan Avenue was originally scheduled to end in September 2023; however, due to extended watermain disinfection procedures, the work on these streets has been rescheduled to end in late November 2023.

We know this project has an impact to all businesses and residents along Progress Avenue and Glamorgan Avenue. We appreciate your patience with the dust, noise, fencing and other inconveniences while we work to complete this City infrastructure project.
