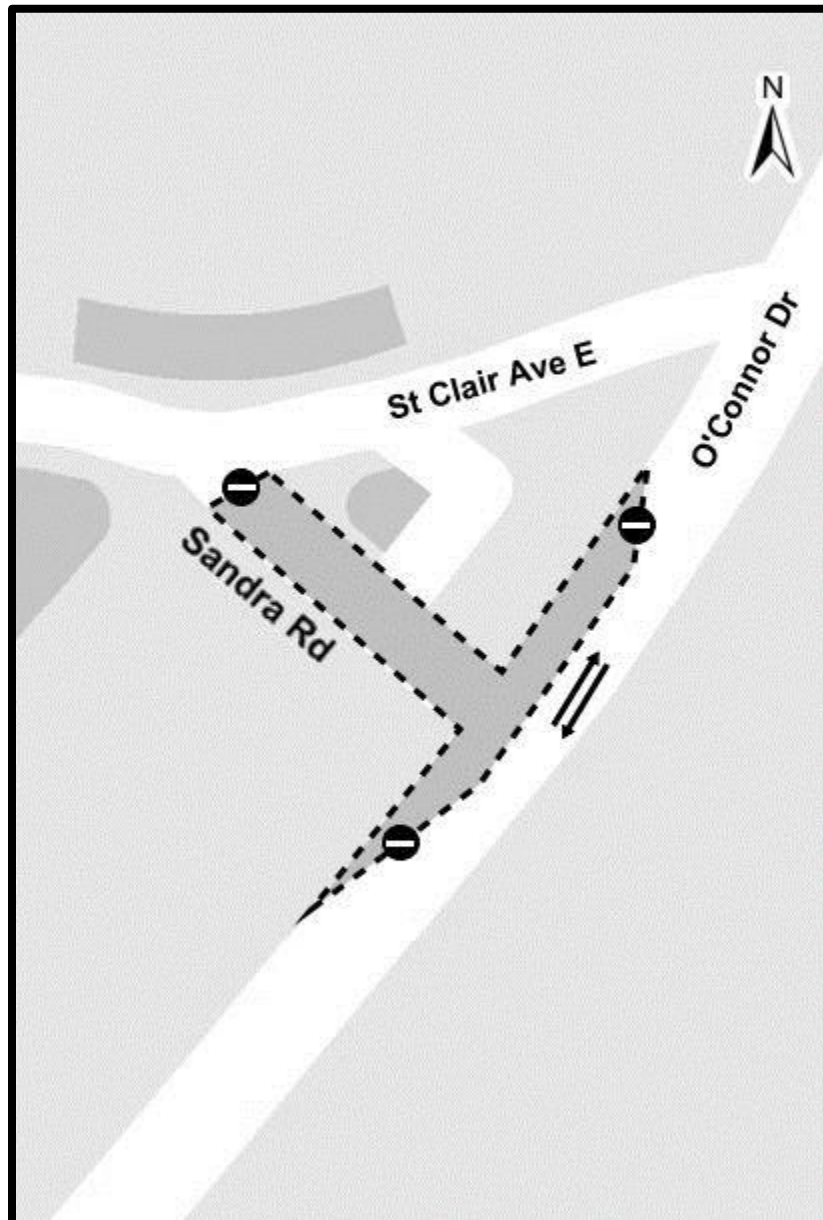
## TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE Sandra Road from St. Clair Avenue East to O'Connor Drive

**Contract: 20ECS-LU-03FP**  
**Start Date: October 03, 2023. End Date: October 10, 2023.**  
*\*Timeline is subject to change.*

The City of Toronto is modifying and upgrading the storm and sanitary sewer system in your area in order to reduce surface and basement flooding. Due to the nature of the road reconstruction work at the intersection of Sandra Road and O'Connor Drive, **Sandra Road will be closed from October 03 to October 10.**




Motorists are reminded to abide by traffic/construction signs posted in local areas to ensure the safe travel of all local road users, pedestrians, and cyclists.

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- The community will experience dust, noise, and traffic delays.
- The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. Your patience is appreciated.

	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b> Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents.</p> <p><b>Traffic Management:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sandra Road will be closed west of O'Connor Drive to St. Clair Avenue East during the duration of the work.</li> <li>• Access to all driveways will be maintained.</li> <li>• O'Connor Drive will be reduced to one lane in both directions.</li> </ul>
	<p><b>Pedestrians:</b> Sidewalks will be kept open for pedestrian use. When work is taking place on the sidewalk, signage will be placed to provide information about which side of the road to use.</p>
	<p><b>Work Hours:</b> Work will take place from <b>7 a.m. to 7 p.m.</b>, Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p> <p>Extended work hours help to minimize traffic disruption, congestion and to shorten the project duration.</p>
