## Road Rehabilitation and Bike Lane Updates on Huntingwood Drive from Pharmacy Avenue to Kennedy Road

**Contract: 23ECS-RD-08MR**

**Start Date: August 4, 2023 Expected End Date: October 31, 2024**

*\*Timeline is subject to change.*

This notice is to provide an update on the road rehabilitation and bike lane improvements on Huntingwood Drive from Pharmacy Avenue to Kennedy Road.

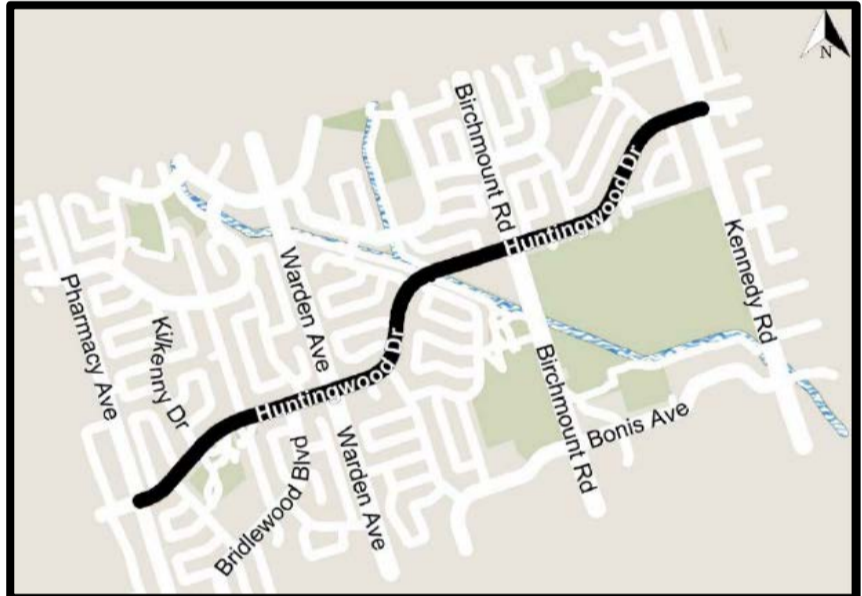
The Phase 1 of base asphalt paving has been completed, and the project is progressing towards the construction of the new concrete medians and planters, to improve the existing bicycle lanes. All existing parking and driveway access on the street will be retained.

Future updates regarding key dates and completed work will be provided as construction progresses.

### MAP OF WORK AREA

Construction will take place in multiple phases between July 2023 and October 2024

- Phase 1, expected completion date of November 10, 2023: east of Pharmacy Avenue to west of Warden Avenue
- Phase 2, May to July 2024: west of Kennedy Road to west of Birchmount Road
- Phase 3, August to October 2024: east of Warden Avenue to west of Dunmurray Boulevard



### WORK STATUS TO DATE

The City's contractor has:

- Completed sidewalk, curb and gutter construction
- Completed Phase 1 base asphalt paving

### REMAINING WORK








- Installation of raised median islands and planters to improve the existing bike lanes and overall bike lane safety
- Construction of raised TTC bus platforms
- Contractor to apply the final layer of asphalt to the roadway
- Pedestrian Crossover improvements at the intersection of Huntingwood Drive and Kilkenny Drive

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.



**Work Hours:** Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.

	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b> Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents.</p> <p>Traffic on Jane Street will be reduced to one lane in each direction</p>
	<p><b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p><b>Driveway Access:</b> The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p><b>Pedestrians:</b> The work may require temporary sidewalk restrictions, however any necessary sidewalk closures will alternate in each direction to ensure pedestrian access is maintained during construction.</p>
	<p><b>Cyclists:</b> If travelling on Huntingwood Drive, please share the traffic lane in the active work zones</p>
	<p><b>Parking:</b> This project will affect on-street parking. Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated with no charge to the owner. Please call 416-808-2222 for its location.</p>
	<p><b>Parking Violation Notice:</b> If parking enforcement is called to a street, officers must issue a yellow parking violation notice (ticket) to vehicles in violation of parking by-laws. If you receive a yellow notice during this construction work, do the following within 15 days of the notice date:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Contact the site inspector or person listed on the Construction Notice and give them the yellow notice number.</li> <li>2) Dispute the parking violation notice online or in person following the process listed on the back of the parking violation notice.</li> </ol> <p><b>You may use this construction notice as part of the explanation of why the violation should be cancelled. Please note:</b> violation notices cannot be cancelled if vehicles are parked in illegal parking spots (i.e. in front of a fire hydrant or in no parking zones).</p> <p>In an effort to reduce ticketing due to construction, please exercise patience with neighbours who are experiencing construction and may need to temporarily park on your street.</p>
	<p><b>Accessible Accommodation:</b> The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.</p>
