Watermain Replacement on Anson Avenue from Brimley Road to Randall Crescent, and Water Service Replacement on Brimley Road from Oakridge Drive to 100 m South of Anson Avenue

Original End Date: September 20, 2023 | New End Date: November 10, 2023



The City of Toronto will replace the watermain and the City-owned portion of substandard water services on Anson Avenue from Brimley Road to Randall Crescent and Water Service Replacement on Brimley Road from Oakridge Drive to 100 m South of Anson Avenue.

Work on Anson Avenue and Brimley Road was originally scheduled to end in September 2023; however, due to unforeseen conditions outside of the contractor's control, such as inclement weather, and additional scope, the work on these streets has been rescheduled to end on November 10, 2023.

We know this project has an impact to all businesses and residents along Anson Road and Brimley Road. We appreciate your patience with the dust, noise, fencing and other inconveniences while we work to complete this City infrastructure project.
