Watermain Replacement on Oakvale Avenue from Greenwood Avenue to end of street

Contract: 23ECS-LU-07SU

Original Start Date: May 18, 2023 | New Start Date: July 4, 2023 Original End Date: August 8, 2023 | New End Date: November 10, 2023 *Timeline is subject to change.

This notice provides an update on the replacement of the watermain and the City-owned portion of substandard water services on Oakvale Avenue from Greenwood Avenue to end of street.

The proposed work on Oakvale Avenue was originally scheduled to end in August 2023; however, due to unforeseen conditions outside of the contractor's control, such as schedule conflicts with other City improvements, inclement weather, and utility investigations, the work is anticipated to end November 10, 2023.

We know this project has an impact to all residents along Oakvale Avenue. We sympathize and appreciate your patience with the dust, noise, fencing and other inconveniences while we work to improve important City infrastructure.
