

This notice provides an update on the ongoing construction work on the streets listed above. Work on Duplex Avenue from Chaplin Crescent to Berwick Avenue, Chaplin Crescent, Manor Road West, and Glebe Road West is behind schedule. It was originally scheduled to end on October 16, 2023; however, due to scheduling conflicts with Eglington Crosstown LRT, the start of construction was delayed. The work on these streets has been rescheduled to end on November 30, 2023.

Work on Duplex Avenue from Berwick Avenue to Eglington Avenue West, Berwick Avenue, and on Duplex Crescent was originally scheduled to begin in May 2023; however, due to scheduling conflicts with Eglinton Crosstown LRT, the work on these streets has been rescheduled to start in Spring 2024. Another construction notice will be provided prior to work starting on these streets in 2024.

We know this project has an impact to all businesses and residents along Duplex Avenue, Berwick Avenue, Chaplin Crescent, Manor Road West, and Glebe Road West. We appreciate your patience with the dust, noise, fencing and other inconveniences while we work to complete this City infrastructure project.

To date the City's contractor has:

- Completed watermain installation on Duplex Ave from Chaplin to Berwick.
- Completed flushing and disinfection testing.
- Completed water service connections.
