

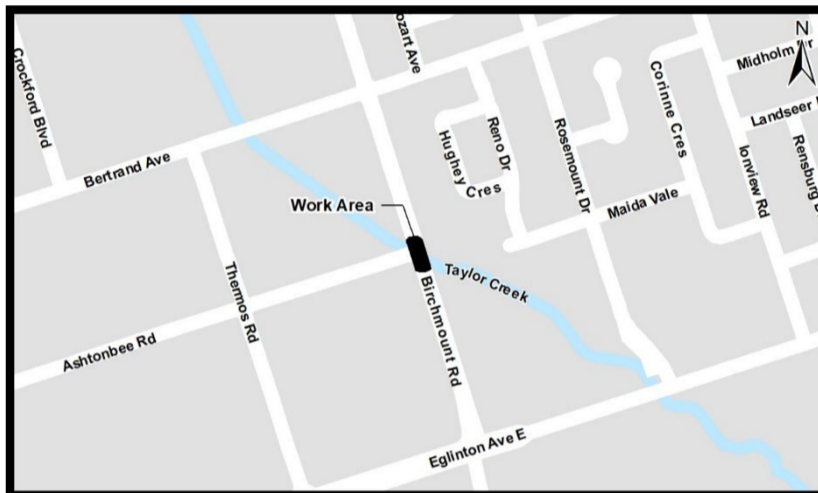

Birchmount Road Culvert Replacement over Taylor Massey Creek

Contract: 23ECS-BE-08BSE
Start Date: November 2023 End Date: August 2024
**Timeline is subject to change.*

The City of Toronto is planning to replace the Culvert at Birchmount Road over Taylor Massey Creek. This work will ensure that the culvert remains serviceable for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2023 Capital Works Program.

WORK DETAILS

The City’s contractor will:





- Replace the existing culvert at Birchmount Road over Taylor Massey Creek
- Rehabilitate existing retaining walls and concrete box culverts at inlet via patch repairs and crack injection
- Construct new cast-in-place concrete headwall to connect the existing inlet structure to the new culverts
- Replace existing gabion basket retaining walls at the outlet with concrete transition structure
- Reinforce existing precast concrete retaining wall in the southeast with an armour stone retaining wall

Construction will take place in the following stages:

Stage 1: November 2023 to February 2024 East side of the culvert on Birchmount Road	7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday. 9 a.m. to 7 p.m., Saturday. Work after hours and on weekends, as required.	Traffic on the Birchmount Road has been reduced to one lane in each direction. Movements for large trucks are restricted at the intersection of Ashtonbee Road and Birchmount Road; <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Large truck left turns from Birchmount Road to Ashtonbee Road are prohibited. • Large Truck left and right turns from Ashtonbee Road to Birchmount Road are prohibited.
Stage 2: February 2024 to June 2024 West side of the culvert on Birchmount Road	7 a.m. to 9 p.m., Monday to Sunday, with work after hours as required.	Traffic on the Birchmount Road has been reduced to one lane in each direction. Ashtonbee Road will be closed during Stage 2 of construction until completion.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- Pre-construction and post construction surveys will be completed at residences within 30 metres of the work area

	<p>Work Hours: During Stage 1 of construction, work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. Saturday, with work after hours and on weekends as required</p> <p>During Stage 2 of construction, work will take place from 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. Monday to Sunday, with work after hours as required.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout construction with one sidewalk opened at all times. Pedestrians will be required to cross the road at the nearest crosswalk to access the opened sidewalk during construction.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users.</p> <p>The traffic management plan is shown in the table on Page one (1) of this Construction Notice.</p>
	<p>Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the Field Ambassador listed below.</p>
