This notice provides an update on the infrastructure improvements that are being carried out by the City of Toronto and the Toronto Transit Commission (TTC) on Adelaide Street and includes important information about upcoming intersection closures taking place this month.

A majority of the cycle track relocation has been completed, and utility relocation work is nearing completion. The installation of new streetcar tracks from York Street to Victoria Street will begin this month.


Work Hours: Streetcar track installation will take place 24 hours, 7 days a week. Excavation activities and heavy breaking of concrete will be carried out at various times throughout the day. All concrete breaking activities will occur between 7 a.m. and 11 p.m.

Interest Toronto Construction Update #3



Around-the-clock work is required during rail installation by TTC crews to preserve the integrity and quality of new rail and concrete. Overnight rail work by TTC may consist of moving new rail into position, rail installation and rail welding/grinding. Concrete breaking work is the most disruptive and will typically last the first 2 days of this phase of construction.
