
Huntingwood Drive Culvert Replacement over West Highland Creek

Contract: 23ECS-BE-07BSE
Start Date: November 2023 End Date: June 2024

*Timeline is subject to change.

The City of Toronto is planning to replace the Culvert at Huntingwood Drive over the West Highland Creek. This work will ensure that the existing culvert remains serviceable for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2023 Capital Works Program.

WORK DETAILS

The City's contractor will:

- Replace the existing culvert at Huntingwood Drive over West Highland Creek
- Remove existing concrete retaining walls, and install precast concrete retaining walls
- Remove and replace gabion baskets to facilitate construction access
- Install chain-link fence above new retaining walls
- Roadway reconstruction and active transportation works including paving, waterproofing and boulevard works

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

• You may experience dust, noise, and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.



Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.



Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout construction with one sidewalk open at all times. Pedestrians will be required to cross the road at the nearest crosswalk to access the open sidewalk during construction.

Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users.

Traffic on Huntingwood Drive will be reduced to one lane of traffic in each direction. A temporary signalized pedestrian crossing will be utilized to maintain pedestrian traffic during all stages of construction. The existing TTC bus stop of the south side of Huntingwood Drive will be relocated to accommodate construction.



Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the **Field Ambassador** listed below.



TTC Impacts: Some TTC stops along Beechgrove Drive may be impacted during the work. Signage will be erected to direct bus users to temporary bus stop locations. Visit ttc.ca for accurate schedule information.
