EHON Major Streets Study

The City is studying the properties within our designated Neighbourhoods along major streets not affected by other growth policies to facilitate more low-rise housing, increase housing choice and access, and to help make Toronto a more livable city. The following seven principles were identified to inform the Major Street Study:

- Provide more housing opportunity in the Neighbourhoods on Major Streets
- Provide incremental development that fit into the existing neighbourhood context with modest changes
- Allow more building types townhouses, stacked townhouses, small scale apartments (up to 6 stories) buildings in the Neighbourhoods on Major Streets
- Provide retail and live/work opportunities
- Consider both the existing and planned context and the site-specific attributes of the lots and increase the number of dwelling units on assembling the existing lots
- Preserve existing mature trees and enhance soft landscape spaces
- Consolidate and minimize curb cuts on major streets and use other streets/laneways at side or rear of the property for access
