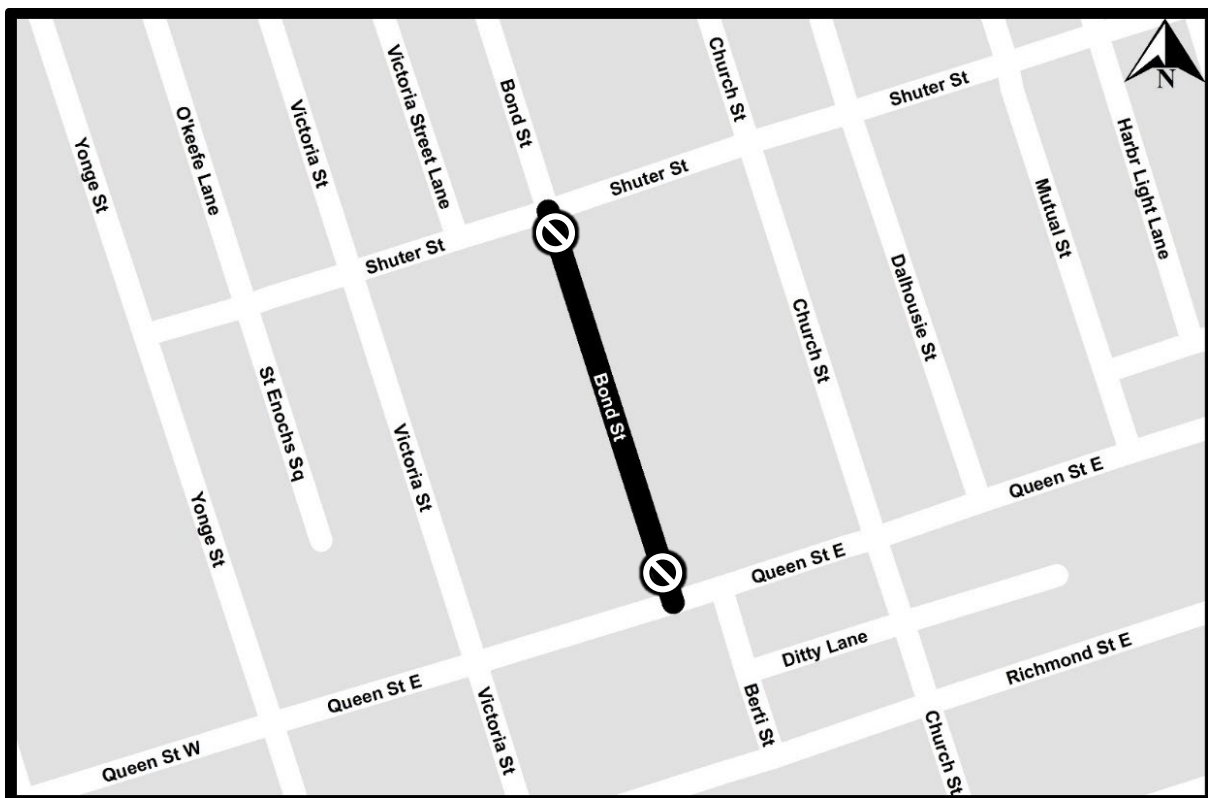

This notice provides an update on the replacement of the watermain and City-owned portion of substandard water services on Bond Street from Queen Street East to Shuter Street.

Bond Street will experience a full road closure on from Queen Street East to Shuter Street during the week of November 6, 2023. This closure is required to complete watermain construction while accommodating St. Michael's Hospital operations and their active construction.

We know this project has an impact to all businesses and residents along Bond Street. We appreciate your patience with the dust, noise, fencing and other inconveniences while we work to complete this City infrastructure project.
