

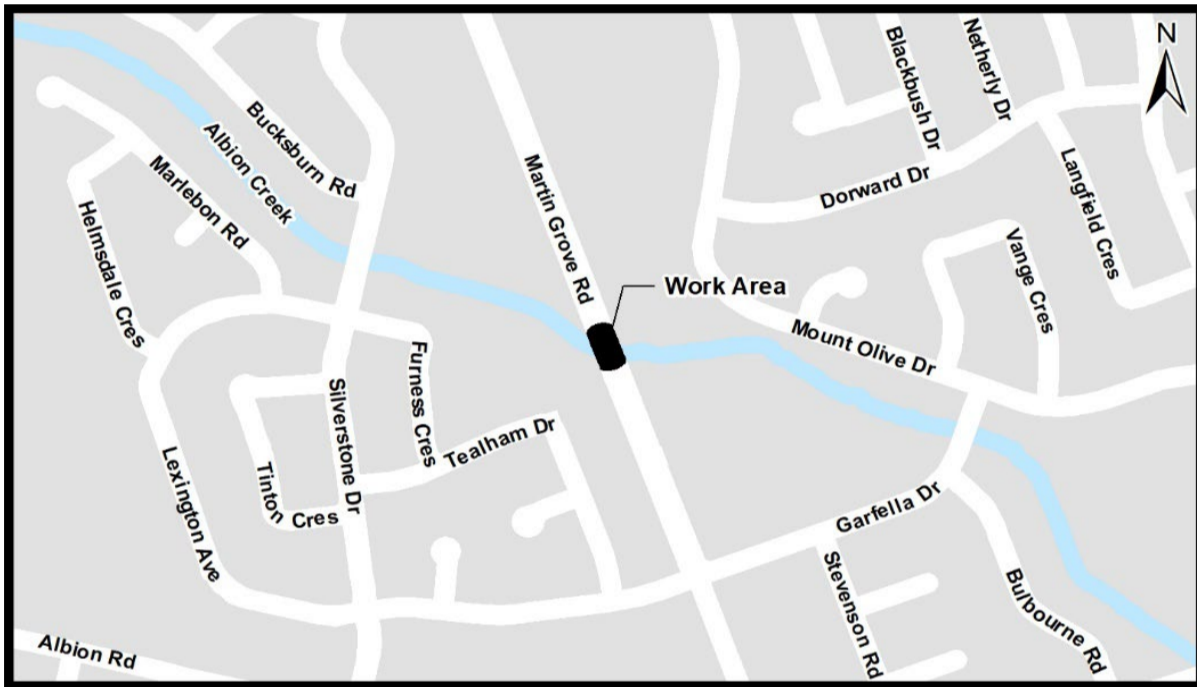

Martin Grove Road Culvert Replacement over Albion Creek

Contract: 23ECS-BE-06BSE
Start Date: December 2023 End Date: August 2024

The City of Toronto is replacing the Culvert at Martin Grove Road over Albion Creek. This work will ensure that the culvert meets today’s standard and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2023 Capital Works Program.

WORK DETAILS




The City’s contractor will:

- Earth excavate and backfill
- Replace the existing culvert at Martin Grove Road over Albion Creek
- Remove existing gabion retaining walls, and install of new armour stone retaining walls
- Replace stream bed and bank protection, upstream and downstream of culvert
- Install parapet wall with aluminum railing
- Reconstruct roadway, including sidewalks, paving, waterproofing and boulevard works

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- Pre-construction and post construction surveys will be completed at residences within 30 metres of the work area

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p>

	<p>Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout construction with one sidewalk opened at all times. Pedestrians will be required to cross the road at the nearest signalized crosswalk to access the opened sidewalk during construction. Access to Smithfield Park and Colony Park will be maintained throughout construction (construction will not interfere with trail connections or driveways south of the culvert).</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users.</p> <p>During construction, traffic on Martin Grove Road will be reduced to one lane of traffic in both directions, spanning approximately 200 metres north and south of culvert location. A temporary signalized pedestrian crossing will be utilized to maintain pedestrian traffic during all stages.</p>
	<p>Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the Field Ambassador listed below.</p>
	<p>TTC Impacts: Some TTC stops along Martin Grove Road may be impacted during the work. Signage will be erected to direct bus users to temporary bus stop locations. Visit ttc.ca for accurate schedule information.</p>
