# TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE Westgate Boulevard at Edinburgh Drive

Expected Start Date: November 09, 2023 Expected End Date: November 17, 2023



The City of Toronto is modifying and upgrading the storm and sanitary sewer system in your area in order to reduce surface and basement flooding. This work also involves replacing the City-owned portion of substandard water services and sanitary sewer laterals.

Due to the existing soil conditions on site and to ensure the safety of everyone, the construction team has closed this section of the road until the current trench is backfilled. This road closure includes night access restrictions. The road will be closed at Westgate Boulevard and Edinburgh Drive, effective 7:00 a.m. on Thursday, November 09, 2023, to 7:00 p.m. on Friday, November 17, 2023. We apologize for any inconvenience that this closure will cause in the neighbourhood, and we thank you for your continued patience as we complete the work.

This project is part of the Council-approved 2022 Basement Flooding Protection Program to improve the water distribution system; renew our aging infrastructure and reduce the risk of sewer collapse or blockages that cause sewer backups and flooding.

**Traffic Management**: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents.

Access at Edinburgh Drive and South of Edinburgh Drive on Westgate Boulevard will not be impacted.



**Pedestrians:** There are no existing sidewalks; However, safe pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.



**Work Hours:** Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday.



**Accessible Accommodation:** The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.
