TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE Intersection of Santa Barbara Road and Tamworth Road

Contract: 21ECS-LU-05FP

Expected Start Date: November 06, 2023 Expected End Date: November 10, 2023

*Timeline is subject to change.

The City of Toronto is modifying and upgrading the storm and sanitary sewer system in your area in order to reduce surface and basement flooding. This work also involves replacing the City-owned portion of substandard water services and sanitary sewer laterals.

Due to the depth and nature of the sanitary sewer construction work on Tamworth Road, and to avoid any safety concerns for the residents in the neighbourhood, the intersection of Tamworth Road and Santa Barbara Road will be partially closed, effective 7:00 a.m. on Monday, November 06, 2023, to 7:00 p.m. on Friday, November 10, 2023. We apologize for any inconvenience that this closure will cause in the neighbourhood, and we thank you for your continued patience as we complete the work.

This project is part of the Council-approved 2022 Basement Flooding Protection Program to improve the water distribution system; renew our aging infrastructure and reduce the risk of sewer collapse or blockages that cause sewer backups and flooding.



Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents.

 Tamworth Road will be partially closed at the intersection between house #146 to house #148. Santa Barbara Road will be closed between house #95 to house #91. There will be a traffic control person at the intersection assisting traffic around the work area in the Tamworth Road and Santa Barbara Road intersection during working hours. Access to homes will remain open.



Pedestrians: The work may require temporary sidewalk restrictions, however any necessary sidewalk closures will alternate in each direction to ensure pedestrian access is maintained during construction.



Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday.


