
Collingsbrook Boulevard Culvert Replacement over West Highland Creek

Contract: 23ECS-BE-07BSE
Start Date: November 2023 End Date: May 2024

The City of Toronto is planning to replace the Culvert at Collingsbrook Boulevard over the West Highland Creek. This work will ensure that the culvert remains serviceable for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2023 Capital Works Program.

WORK DETAILS

The City's contractor will:

- Replace the existing culvert at Collingsbrook Boulevard over West Highland Creek
- Removal of existing steel-bin wingwalls, and installation of reinforced soil slope retaining walls
- Installation of chain-link fence above new RSS retaining walls
- Embankment restoration including installation of vegetated rock buttress at all four quadrants

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

 You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.



Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.



Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout construction with one sidewalk open. Pedestrians will be required to cross the road at the nearest crosswalk to access the open sidewalk during construction.



Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users.



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Collingsbrook Boulevard traffic will be reduced to a single, northbound lane for the duration of construction. A temporary signalized pedestrian crossing, located to the south of the culvert, will be utilized to maintain pedestrian traffic during both stages.
