**NEW End Date: Spring 2024**

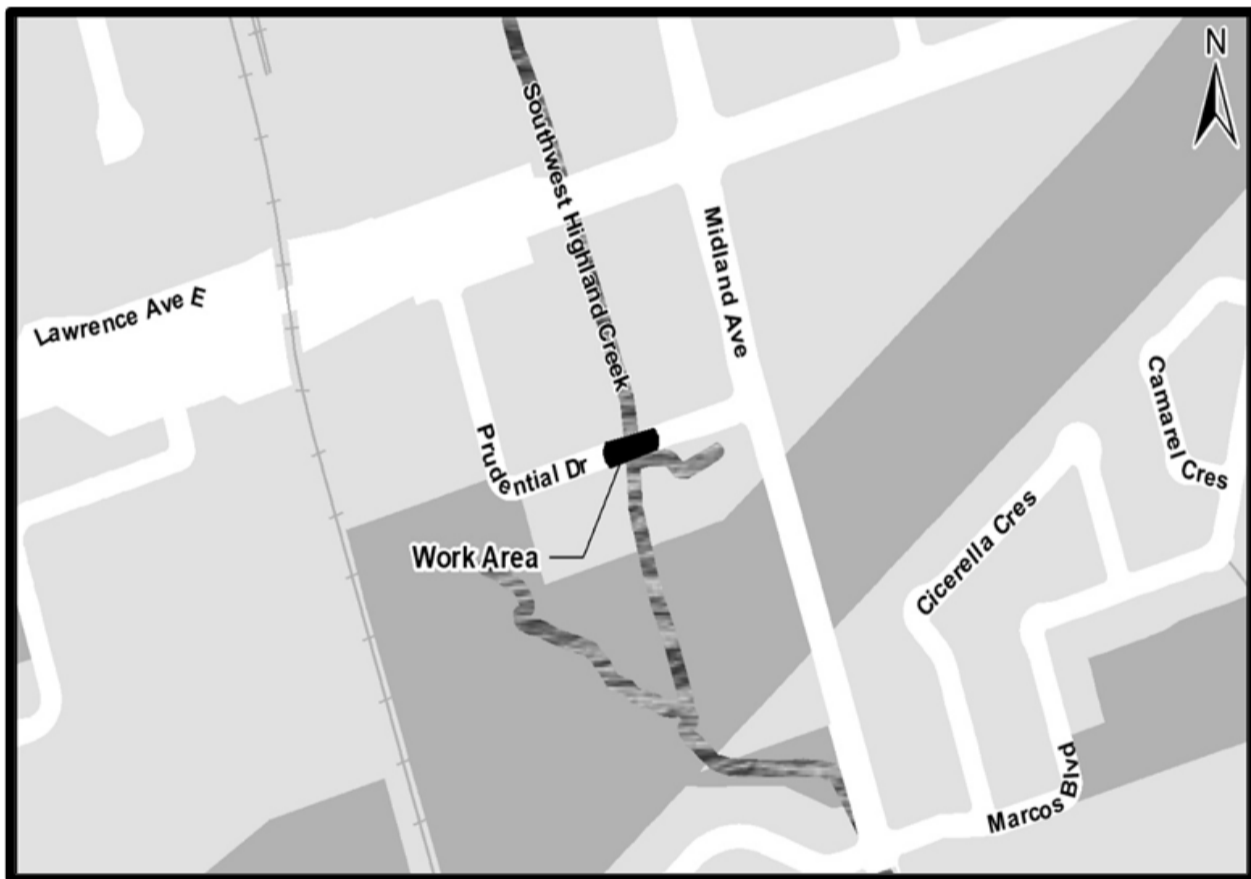

This notice provides an update on the Replacement of Prudential Drive Culvert over West Highland Creek.

Work on this project is currently behind schedule. This delay was caused by an unexpected culvert collapse and a supply chain issue that resulted in an interruption in the work while materials were procured to safely relocate a Toronto Hydro underground duct bank.

We know this project has an impact to all businesses and residents along Prudential Drive. We sympathize and appreciate your patience with the dust, noise, fencing and other inconveniences.

### WORK STATUS TO DATE

The City's contractor has:







- Temporarily relocated utilities
- Installed a flume bypass for waterflow in the creek
- Constructed a new concrete culvert and retaining walls
- Reconnected watermain and sewer pipes

### REMAINING WORK

- Restore underground utilities
- Reconstruct roadway and sidewalks
- Reconstruct stream bed
- Restore site and open road
- Seeding, planting and final paving (in Spring 2024)

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

	<p><b>Work Hours:</b> Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b> Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents.</p> <p><b>Access to Midland Ave from Prudential Drive will be closed for pedestrians and motorists</b></p>
	<p><b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p><b>Driveway Access:</b> The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p><b>Parking:</b> This project will affect on-street parking. Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated with no charge to the owner. Please call 416-808-2222 for its location.</p>
	<p><b>Parking Violation Notice:</b> If parking enforcement is called to a street, officers must issue a yellow parking violation notice (ticket) to vehicles in violation of parking by-laws. If you receive a yellow notice during this construction work, do the following within 15 days of the notice date:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Contact the site inspector or person listed on the Construction Notice and give them the yellow notice number.</li> <li>2) Dispute the parking violation notice online or in person following the process listed on the back of the parking violation notice.</li> </ol> <p><b>You may use this construction notice as part of the explanation of why the violation should be cancelled. Please note:</b> violation notices cannot be cancelled if vehicles are parked in illegal parking spots (i.e. in front of a fire hydrant or in no parking zones).</p>
	<p><b>Accessible Accommodation:</b> The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the <b>Field Ambassador</b> listed below.</p>
