WAYS YOU CAN REDUCE YOUR WASTE AND YOUR CLIMATE IMPACT

The City of Toronto manages close to 900,000 tonnes of waste each year. This requires money, energy and resources and takes up limited landfill space.

SMALL CHANGES CAN MAKE A BIG IMPACT. TRY THESE EASY WAYS TO REDUCE YOUR WASTE.



REFUSE: Do not take items unless you are going to use them. Say 'no' to receipts and extra packaging, napkins and cutlery.

REUSE: Use reusable bags for shopping and gift giving and reusable bottles, containers, dishes and cutlery at events instead of single-use items.



REPURPOSE: Find new uses for things you would otherwise throw away such as turning old clothes into rags and old jars into vases.



SWAP/BORROW/SHARE: Create or join a group where you can exchange, borrow or share less frequently used items, such as tools, party supplies, camping gear and sports equipment.



REPAIR: Extend the life of items like clothing, appliances and electronics by repairing them.



SHOP CONSCIOUSLY: Plan ahead, buy only what you need and consider the amount of packaging when making purchases.

DONATE: Give items a new life by donating them.

REDUCE FOOD WASTE AND KEEP Organics out of landfill

When food waste ends up in landfill it creates harmful greenhouse gas emissions, which contribute to climate

change. Reduce your food waste by planning your meals, buying only what you need, storing food correctly, making the most of leftovers and using your Green Bin for unavoidable food waste, such as bones, eggshells and tea bags.

Instead of buying new bags, there are more cost-effective and planet-friendly options to consider. Try reusing items such as online shipping bags, paper takeaway bags, bread bags and milk bags or overwrap from toilet paper and paper towel.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

Items that are corrosive, flammable, explosive or poisonous are considered Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) and must not be placed in your garbage, Blue Bin recycling or Green Bin organics and should never be poured down the drain, toilet or sewer.

HHW requires special handling because it can harm workers and cause fires and explosions in collection trucks and at waste management facilities. Improper disposal of HHW also has negative effects on our environment and can be harmful to humans and animals.

KNOW WHICH ITEMS IN YOUR HOME ARE CONSIDERED HAZARDOUS WASTE. THESE INCLUDE:

Bringing it to a Community Environment Day (learn more at toronto.ca/environment days)

Arranging a free Toxic Taxi pickup of 10 to 50 L/kg of HHW. Visit toronto.ca/311 or

contact 311 to request a pickup. In an apartment or condo building, pickup must be

- Batteries (also see lithium-ion batteries on this page)
- Paint, stains, turpentine, glue
- Household cleaning products, drain cleaners, bleach

DISPOSAL OPTIONS

You can dispose of your HHW by:

- Propane and helium tanks/cylinders Non-empty aerosol cans
- Syringes, medical sharps, medication
- Pesticides and garden products
- Lighting (e.g. bulbs, fluorescent tubes, CFLs, LEDs, halogen bulbs)

LITHIUM-ION BATTERIES

Lithium-ion batteries, found in everyday household products such as wireless headphones, handheld power tools, laptops, cell phones, e-bikes and e-scooters, are considered HHW. These batteries should **never** be discarded in the garbage or Blue Bin recycling because they present a risk of fire. To safely dispose of lithium-ion batteries, please use one of the safe disposal options (see Disposal Options on this page).

ELECTRONIC WASTE

Electronic waste should **never** be put in the Blue Bin recycling. Electronic waste is collected separately at the curb on garbage day or can be brought to a Drop-Off Depot (see pages 6 and 7) or a Community Environment Day. Residents of apartments and condos should take electronics to their building's designated drop-off area.

Remember to protect your privacy and clear all personal information from electronics prior to collection, drop-off or donation.
