# Port Union Road Improvements from Lawrence Avenue East to Island Road

### Contract: 22ECS-TI-22SP Start Date: July 2023 End Date: December 2024

\*Timeline is subject to change.

In July 2023, the City of Toronto began infrastructure improvements on Port Union Road from Island Road to Lawrence Avenue East. This notice provides an update on the status of work to date.

Starting mid-December and throughout the winter months, there will be a break in road reconstruction activity. The road and sidewalk will be temporarily restored, and an additional southbound travel lane will reopen. During the winter months the contractor will relocate hydro poles on the west side of Port Union Road between Island Road and Lawrence Avenue East. Temporary lane closures may be required.

Construction updates will continue to be provided via email, and a Construction Update notice will be issued before road reconstruction work resumes in Spring 2024.

## WORK STATUS TO DATE

Since this project started in summer 2023, the contractor has completed the following work:

- Installed temporary signals at the intersections of Island Road and Lawson Road
- Removed traffic islands at both intersections
- Tree cutting on east and west sides between Island Road and Lawson Road
- Completed temporary road widening between Island Road and Lawson Road
- Installed new retaining walls at Rozell Road and Lawson Road.

## **REMAINING WORK**

Beginning in spring 2024 the contractor will:

- Excavate and remove the existing road surface and base for road widening and reconstruction from Island Road to Lawrence Avenue East
- Replace the City-owned portion of substandard water service connections from Lawson Road to Lawrence Avenue East
- Construct a new retaining wall near Adam's Creek
- Construct raised cycle tracks and new sidewalk from Island Road to Lawrence Avenue East
- Construct new curb extensions from Island Road to Lawrence Avenue East
- Restore all areas affected by construction.
